NOTIFICATION

No. 12018/40/80-APT (B), the 23rd July, 1992. In exercise of the powers conterred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the Post of Assistant Soil & Water Conservation Engineer (ASCE) under Soil and Water Conservation Department, Govi, of Mizoran.

1. Short title and (i) commencement.

- These rules may be called, the Minoram Soil & Water Conservation Department (Caleups B posts) Recruitment Rules 1992.
- (ii) They shall come into force from the date of their pub-

Disquelification.

The rules shall apply to the post (s) specified in Col. I of the Aunexure I hereto and red.

The number of the said point, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 to the Angeoure d aforesaid.

The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Anneatre-I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct rectt. may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt, of Mizoram from time to time.

No person.

(a) Who has entered into or sontracted a marriage with a person having a sponse living;

(b) who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personnal law applicable to such person and the other party to to marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rules.

6. Training and Depart- Every Govt. Servant shall undergo such training or pass mental Examination. such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

> 6 (a) Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest, have the right and power to transfer any Officer or Official, recruited in accordance with these Rules to the post/posts/service specified in schedule/ Annexure to these rules to rany other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

7. Power to relax.

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Selection Committee/Departmental Promotion Committee through the Department of Personal & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

8. Reservation, other concession.s

Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concesssion required to be provided for the Scheduled Caste, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories or persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regards.

9. Repeal & Saving.

All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Assam or by the Government of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Natification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dated 21.1.1972 and No. A. 12018/40/80-APT (B) dt. 9.9.1987 and No. 12018/40/80-APT (B) dt. 2.6.1992 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary therato, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
