NOTIFICATION

RULES FOR SANCTION OF REHABILITATION AND EX-GRATIA GRANT TO POLICE PERSONNEL WHO DIED ON DUTY/SUSTAINED INJURY IN OPERATION AGAINST INSURGENCY/TERRORISTS /COMMUNAL RIOTS AND MOB VIOLENCE.

1. **SHORT TITLE :** These Rules may be called the Mizoram (Payment of ex-gratia grant to Police personnel who died while on duty/sustained injury in operation against insurgency, terrorists, communal riots and mob violence) Rules, 1992.
2. **OBJECTIVE :** These Rules provide for payment of financial assistance to the victims or heirs dependants of victims of insurgency/terrorists/extremist activities, communal riots and mob violence.
3. **TYPES OF ASSISTANCE :** (a) The best treatment available in Government Hospitals in the State shall be arranged for those injured in connection with insurgency/terrorists or extremist activities, communal riots and mob violence. Powers for purchase of medicines etc. in the open market as and when necessary will be exercised by the Medical Superintendent/Chief District Medical and Health Officer/Medical and Health Officer. Cases of seriously injured victims shall be referred to the Hospitals outside the State if treatment is not available within the State, at Government expense.

(b) Financial assistance shall be given to the victims or their heirs/dependants as per the scale laid down in Rule, 5. Permanent incapacitation shall be decided on the basis of the certificate issued by the Chairman of the Board of Medical Examination of the concerned District. This certificate should specify details of the incidents as per record maintained by the Police and the nature of injuries.
4. **ELIGIBILITY :** Victims of insurgency/extremist activities, communal riots and mob violence shall be entitled to the benefit under these Rules.

5. NATURES AND QUANTUM OF GRANTS : The following scales of ex-gratia grants & shall be sanctioned to the victims or their heirs/dependants :

| (a) Death (whether there is any earning or non-earning member of the family) | - Rs. 50,000/- |

| (c) Temporary incapacitation | - Rs. 10,000/- |
| (d) Grievous hurt (short of incapacitation) | - Rs. 5,000/- |

6. PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED IN SANCTIONING GRANT :

(a) DGP/IGP, Mizoram shall submit application with justification for ex-gratia grant under the scheme to the Home Department for consideration of the Government.

(b) The Director, Rehabilitation will make payment to the victims or their heirs/dependants through DGP/IGP, Mizoram after ex-gratia is sanctioned by the Government.

7. MAINTENANCE OF ACCOUNTS : Proper accounts of payments of ex-gratia shall be maintained by the Director, Relief & Rehabilitation as given below :-

(i) A certificate issued by the DGP/IGP Mizoram to the effect that ex-gratia payment is released to the victims, their heirs or dependants for the reason for which it has been sanctioned.

(ii) A suitable Register of sanction shall be maintained in which all the relevant information shall be entered.

(iii) Actual Payee's Receipt shall be obtained from the persons receiving the ex-gratia grants.

(iv) A Register shall be maintained in which full details leading to payment including voucher number and date and Bank Draft number and date if payments are made in Bank Draft, shall be entered.

(v) The expenditure will be debitable under the head "2235-Social Security Welfare, 60-Other Social Security Welfare, 800-Other Expenditure 800 (1)-Ex-gratia Grant, 60/800 (1) (26)-Other charges.
