8. **Reservation, other concessions:** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other concessions, required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regards.

9. **Repeal & Saving:** All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Govt. of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMP (ii) dated. 21.1. 1972 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
