NOTIFICATION

No. LAD/VC-71/92/pt (A) the 14th, September, 1992. Whereas the Government has constituted a village council in the re-settled villages of New Vervek, Sakawrdai, Vaitin and Zohmun under section 3(3) of the Lushai Hills District (village Councils) Act, 1953 vide Govt. Notification No. LAD/VC-12/92/57 dt 8.7.92

And whereas Mauchar, Palsang, North Tinghmun villages were re-settled at Zohmun and Thingsat, North Khawdungsei, Villages were re-settled at Sakawrdai, and Khawpuar village was also re-settled at Vaitin, these shifted villages should automatically be under the administrative control of the village councils to which they were re-settled. Since these shifted villages no longer formed separate village assumption of the charges of these villages by the BDO/AO vide Govt. Notification No.LAD/VC-1/90 dt15.11.1990 is withdrawn with immediate effect. All the properties of their village councils kept by the BDO/AO should be handed over to the village councils concerned to which the village is re-settled immediately.

The newly constituted virlage councils under the Govt. Notification referred to above are competent to make allotment of house sites within their respective jurisdictions within the meaning of section 3(1) of the Lushai Hills District (nou se site) Act, 1953. Distributions of jhuming lands within the deserted villages should also come under the control of the respective village councils to which they were re-settled.
