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NOTIFICATION

No. DCA/N-55/82, the 20th November 1992. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-paragraph (6) of paragraph 2 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules, 1974, as follows:-

Short title and commencement

1. (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) (Amendment) Rules, 1992.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of publication in the official Gazette.

Amendment of rule 22.

2. In the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitutions and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules, 1974 (here-in-after referred to as the Principal Rules), in rule 22, for clause (b) of sub-rule (1), the following clause shall be substituted, namely-

"(b) may at any time by writing signed by his hand submit his resignation, if a member is the Chief Executive Member, through the Chairman and if such member is a member of the Executive Committee, through the Chief Executive Member to the Governor. On his resignation being accepted by the Governor, the Chief Executive Member or the Executive Member, as the case may be, shall be deemed to have vacated his office"

Amendment of rule 23

3. In the Principal Rules, for rule 23, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-
23. Resignation of member of the Executive Committee:— (1) The Executive Committee shall be collectively responsible to the District Council and may be

removed on a vote of no confidence passed by a majority of the Members of the District Council at a meeting specially convened for the purpose.

(2) Member or Members of the Executive Committee shall hold office during the pleasure of Chief Executive Member and may be removed by an order of the Chief Executive Member.

(3) In case of removal of the Executive Committee, a Chief Executive Member for the new Executive Committee shall be elected within 48 hours by the District Council, and when this has been done, the Chairman of the District Council shall forthwith submit a report to the Governor through the Deputy Commissioner

(4) If the District Council fails to elect Chief Executive Member within the time specified under sub-rule (3), the Governor shall appoint any member of the Council to be the Chief Executive Member and other Members of the Council as Members of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee so constituted shall function until it is replaced by an Executive Committee constituted in accordance with the provision of rule 24.
