NOTHICATION

No. A. 12018/4/90-P&AR(GSW), the 21st December, 1992. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Dy. Commissioner (1ech.) Apprendiate/AH & VETY/Industries, Govt. of Mizoram, namely:

- 1. Short title and (i) These rules may be called the Mizoram R.D. Deptt. commencement. (Group A post) Recruitment Rules, 1992.
 - (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publica-
- 2. Application.

The Rules shall apply to the post spinified in Col. 1 of the Annexure-I hereto conexad.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.

The number of the said possife, their classification and the scale of pay attacked thereto shall be as specified in col. 2 to 4 of the Assexure 1 afteresaid.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification. The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the Annexure-I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be released at the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes. Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in assordance with the orders issued by the Central Cove or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification.

No person.

- a) Who has entered into or contracted a Marriage with a person having a spouse living.
- b) Who having a spouse living has entered into or contrancted marriage with any persons shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor may it satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personnel law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any personal from the operation of rules

Every Govt. servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

- Not withstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest, have the right and power to transfer any Officer or Official, recruited in accordance with these Rules to the post/posts/service specified in schedule/Annexure to these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Selection Committee/Departmental Promotion Committee through the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions and these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons. Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation and other concession required to be provided for the Schedule caste, the schedule Tribe and other categories or persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central
 - All Rule pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Assam and were in force in the enswhile Mizo District an continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No.14/21/71-HMP (ii) dated 21.1,4972 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
