The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 4th January, 1994, and is hereby published for general information :—

THE HIGH COURT SUPREME COURT JUDGES
(CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) AMENDMENT ACT,
1993.

No. 2 of 1994

(4th January, 1994.)

An Act further to amend the High Court Judges (Conditions of Service) Act, 1954 and the Supreme Court Judges (Conditions of Service) Act 1958.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Forty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be called the High Court and Supreme Court Judges (Conditions of Service) Amendment Act, 1993.

Short title and commencement

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1986.

Amendment of section 22D of Act, 28 of 1954.

2. In the High Court Judges (Conditions of Service) Act, 1954, in section 22D, after clause (c), the following clause shall be inserted namely :—

“(d) the value of leave travel concession provided to a Judge and members of his family,”.

Amendment of section 23D of Act, 41 of 1958.

3. In the Supreme Court Judges (Conditions of Service) Act, 1958, in section 23D, after clause (c), the following clause shall be inserted, namely :—

“(d) the value of leave travel concession provided to a Judge and members of his family,”.
