## NOTIFICATION

No. B. 17011/15/89-TRP, the 11th December, 1995. In supersession of this Department's Notification of even No. Dt. 30.5.1995, and in exercise of the power conferred under Section 200 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act No.59 of 1988), the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to authorise the following Officers to compound traffic offences committed under the said Act and punishable under Sections mentioned in Column 2 of the schedule below for amounts not more than those specified in corresponding column of the said schedule. The Officers are further authorised for the purposes of sections 206 and 207 of the M.V. Act, 1988, and under the said section of the Act.

4. District Transport Officers/Asstt. District Transport Officers of Transport Department.
5. Assistant Commissioner, Transport Department.
6. Station Superintendents (MST) Transport Department.
7. Asst. Station Superintendents, Transport Department
8. Motor Vehicle Inspectors, Transport Department
9. Station Superintendent (ROA), Transport Department
10. Enforcement-Cum-Traffic Inspectors, Transport Department
11. Any Police Officer not below the rank of Asstt. Inspector of Police.
