### NOTIFICATION

No.B.17011/15/89-TRP: the 13th December, 1995. In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 200 of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988 (Central Act No.59 of 1988), the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to authorise the following Officers to compound traffic offences committed under the said Act and punishable under Sections mentioned in Column 2 of the schedule below, for amounts not more than those specified in corresponding column of the said schedule.

1. Commissioners/Secretaries to the Govt. of Mizoram.
2. Heads of Departments under the Govt. of Mizoram.

The Commissioners/Secretaries and Heads of Departments are also authorised to invoke and exercise the powers available U/S 206 and 207 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 for the purposes of the said two sections only.

Further, the District Magistrates and Sub-Divisional Magistrates will continue to exercise the magisterial powers relating to traffic offences, within their respective jurisdictions, as already empowered by the relevant Act, Rules and Regulations.
