NOTIFICATION

No. 479/74—Whereas the term of office of Shri V.V. Giri, President of India, is due to expire on 23 August, 1974:

AND WHEREAS under sub-section (3) of section 4 of the Presidential and Vice-Presidential Elections Act, 1952 (31 of 1952), the Election Commission is required to appoint the dates for the election to fill the office of the President of India so that it will be completed in time to enable the President thereby elected to enter upon his office on the 24th. day of August, 1974:

NOW THEREFORE in pursuance of sub-section (1) of section 4 of the said Act, the Election Commission hereby appoints in respect of the said election—

- (a) 30 July 1974 (Tuesday), as the last date for making nominations:
- (b) 31 July 1974 (Wednesday), as the date for the scrutiny of nominations:
- (c) 2 August 1974 (Friday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures; and
- (d) 17 August 1974 (Saturday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken.
