

No.A.12018/1/99-PAR(GSW), the 18th April, 2001. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules further to aincid the Mizoram Health Service Rules, 1997 notified vide No.A. 12018 90/80-APT(3) dated 17.6.97 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Vol. XXVI, Extra Ordinary issue No. 363 dated 28.10.97, namely :-

(1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram (Amendment) Rules, 2001. Short title Health Services and comof the Rule. to simblem A . vicessa Anduilleans राड अग्रेम कि

(2) They shall come into force from the date of publication in the official Gazette of Mizoram Government

In the Mizoram Health Services Rules, 1997 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules), for sub-rule (2) of Rule 3 of Amendment of Rule 3. the Principal Rules, the following shall be substituted, namely:

Provided further that the officers holding any of the duty posts of the Service on officiating or adnoc basis shall be inducted into the appropriate Grades of the Service as provided for in these Rules".

Amendment of Rule 8(1).

SHAP OF BUILDING

In the Principal Rules for the Rule 8(1), the following shall be substituted, namely:

"The appointment to any post after initial constitution under rule 3, in the entry grade of services shall be made by direct recruitment conducted by the Mizoram Public Service Commission. The Government shall send requisition to the commission indicating the line of disciplines and numbers of vacancies to be filled."

Amendment of Rule 18(4). In the Principal Rules for Rule 18(4), the following shall be substituted, namely:

Any members of the service in the General Health Service Wing, who has undergone post-graduate course upon completion his/her study, may be placed in the appropriate grade of Hospital & Medical Education Wing subject to his/her willingness and eligibility and availability of vacant post. On such placement he/she shall be placed below the junior most of the speciality as on that day.

Provided that if there is any case not covered by the above provision, the relative seniority of any member shall be determined by the Government.

Deletion of Rule 19(2).

Amendment/ In the Principal Rules, the provisions of Rules 19(2) shall be deleted.
