No. H. 12018/83/98-LJD/98, the 16th April, 2001. The following Act of the Mizoram Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram is hereby published for general information.

The Mizoram Appropriation (No. 1) Act, 2001 (Act No. 3 of 2001)

(Received the assent of the Governor of Mizoram on the 30th March, 2001)

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the consolidated Fund of the State for the Services of the Financial Year of 2000-2001.

It is enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Fifty Second Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short Title

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 1) Act, 2001.

Issues of Rs. 419,09,15,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the Financial Year 2000-2001

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied in Column (5) of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rupees Four Hundred Nineteen Crores, Nine lacs and fifteen thousand only for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the Financial Year 2000-2001 in respect of Service specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.
