## CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION OF AMENDMENT OF BYE-LAWS ( RULE 14 (3) )

No.B.14015/46/2000-RCOOP/69, the 24th April, 2001. In the Office of the Registrar of Cooperative Societies under the Mizoram Cooperative Societies Act, 1991 (Act 19 of 1991).

I do hereby certify that pursuant to the Mizoram Cooperative Societies Act, 1991 (Act 19 of 1991), the amendments shown in the enclosed document of the Bye-Laws of the Mizoram Pig Producers' Cooperative Federation Limited a Cooperative Society registered under the aforesaid Act on the sixth day of June, 1989 under No.AW-29/88-89 in the District of Aizawl has been duly registered. The following is the area of operation of the society :—

WHOLE OF MIZORAM.

TERMS OF OFFICE BEARERS :

2.TERMS OF OFFICE BEARERS :

Elected member of Board of Directors shall retire every year but shall be eligible for re-election. Provided that without prior permission from the Registrar, Cooperative Societies no member shall hold office for more than four (4) years consecutively, but shall be eligible for re-election after a lapse of two years

In the Mizoram Cooperative Societies Rules 1996, for the proviso to Sub-rule(1) of rule 34, the following provisions shall be substituted namely—

Provided that no member shall hold office for more than four (4) years in succession, or having already held office for four (4) years, whether in succession

from the date on which he ceased  
be a member of such body.

or not, be re-elected within a short  
interval than two years from the date on  
which he ceased to be a member of such  
council or body.

Provided further that if the election  
cannot be held for any reason, the gap  
period so occasioned shall not be coun-  
ted to form part of the interval period  
of two years.

Provided further that notwithstanding  
anything contained in the rules to the  
contrary, the Government may appoint  
the Chairman and the other members of  
the Board of Directors or Managing Bo-  
dy of the State Level Cooperatives and  
affiliating societies where the Share  
Capital Contribution of the Government  
exceeds fifty one per centum of the total  
paid up Share Capital of that institution  
in accordance with the provisions in the  
bye-laws for such period as it may con-  
sider necessary.
