### NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/45/80-APT(B)/Vol-I.Pt, the 15th May, 2001. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Food Inspector under Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Mizoram, namely :-

- 1. Short title (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Health and and commencement. Rules, 2001.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application. The Rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the Annexure-1 hereto annexed.
- 3. Number of Posts, The number of the said post (s), their classification and the classification & scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Co-Scale of pay. lumns 2 to 4 of the Annexure-1 aforesaid.
- 4. Method of The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to Rectt., age limit the said post shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 15 of and other quali- the Annexure-I aforesaid: fications.

Provided that the age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification. a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appoin ment to the said post (5).

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these rules.

- Every Government servant recruited under these Rules shall 6. Training and undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examina-Departmental tion as may be prescribed from time to time. Examination.
- Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Go-7. Power to vernor of Mizoram in public interest, shall have the right transfer. and power to transfer any Officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
- 8. Power to relax. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Department of Personnel & Admn. Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Nothing in these Rules shall affect any reservations or other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes and other categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regards.

All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Mizoram under Notification No. MrtE.63/76-77/77 ot. 3.12.1982 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Issue No. 73 dt. 14.12.1982 stand hereby repealed :

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.
