NOTIFICATION

No.A. 12018/2/93 -P&AR (GSW), the 12th June, 2001. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the Post of Joint Commissioner of Taxes under Taxation Department, Government of Mizoram, namely :—

1. Short title (i) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Excise and Taxation and commencement. Department (Group 'A' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2001.
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application. The Rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.
3. Number of post, classification & Scale of pay. The number of the said post(s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Annexure-I aforesaid.
4. Method of Rectt., age limit and other qualifications. The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the Annexure-I aforesaid.

Provided that the age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or the Government of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification. No person—
 - (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post (s) :

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these Rules.

| 6. Training and Departmental Examination. | Every Government servant recruited under these Rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examinations as may be prescribed from time to time. |
| 7. Power to transfer. | Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest shall have the right and power to transfer any Officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade. |
| 8. Power to relax. | Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, in consultation with the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions to these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons. |
| 9. Reservations and other concessions. | Nothing in these Rules shall affect any reservations or other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Tribes/Scheduled Castes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regards. |
