NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/48/2004-P&AR (GSW), the 26th February, 2008. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post(s) of Quarter Guard Lance Naik, Brass Band Lance Naik and Bugler under Mizoram Home Guards Department, Government of Mizoram, namely:—

- Short Title and Commencement. 1. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Home Guards Department (Group 'C' post) Recruitment Rules, 2007.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- Application. 2. These Rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column 1 of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.
- Number of posts, classification and scale of pay. 3. The number of the said posts, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Annexure-1 as aforesaid.
- Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications. 4. The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 14 of the Annexure-I aforesaid.

Provided that the age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time.

fication. (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these rules.

- Power to 7. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor

- Power to 8. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or
