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NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/66/2009-P&AR(GSW) : the 6th April, 2009. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules relating to the post (s) of **LDC/Defence Welfare Worker** under Sainik Welfare & Resettlement Department, namely :-

Short title and Commencement

1. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Sainik Welfare & Resettlement Department (Group 'C' post) Recruitment Rules, 2009.
(2) They shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

Application

2. These Rules shall apply to the post specified in Column 1 of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.

Number of posts Classification and scale of pay

3. The number of the said post (s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Column 2 to 4 of the Annexure-I.

Method of recruitment age limit and other qualification

4. The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in Column 5 to 14 to the Annexure-I aforesaid.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time.

Disqualification

5. No person -
- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post(s).

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these rules.

**Training and
Departmental
Examination**

6. Every Government servant recruited under these rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

Power to transfer

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram, in public interest, shall have the right and power to transfer any officer or official, so recruited under these Rules to any post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

Power to relax

8. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of persons.

**Reservation and
other concessions**

9. Nothing in these rules shall affect any reservations and other concession required to be provided for the Schedules Caste/Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.

**Repeal and
Savings**

10. All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Mizoram under Gazette Notification **No.ABR.153/78/19 dt.3.10.78 for the post of LDC/DWW** stands hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed, or under any general order ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
