NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/68/2009-P&AR(GSW), the 2nd June, 2009. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the post (s) of Driver in various Offices under the Government of Mizoram namely:-

Short title and commencement

- 1. (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram Driver Recruitment Rules, 2009.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

Application

Number of posts, Classification and scale of pay

Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification

- 2. These Rules shall apply to the post (s) specified in column I of the Annexure-I hereto annexed.
- 3. The number of the said post (s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Column 2 to 4 of the Annexure-I
- 4. The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in Column 5 to 14 of the Annexure-I aforesaid.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time.

Disqualification

- 5. No person-
 - (e) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(f) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post(s).

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to the other party to the marriage and that there are other gounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these rules.

- 6. Every Government servant recruited under these rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
- 7. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram, in public interest, shall have the right and power to transfer any officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
- 8. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 9. Nothing in these rules shall affect any reservations and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
- 10. All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Mizoram under Gazette Notification No.A.12018/52/80-APT(B) dated 23.8.96 and its subsequent Amendments No.A.12018/68/2009-P&AR(GSW) dt.2.4.2009 published in the Mizoram Gazette Issue No. 152 dt.3.4.2009 for the post of Driver stand hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed, or under any general order ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
