NOTIFICATION

No. A. 12018/56/2005-P&AR(GSW), the 26th February, 2010. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules further to amend the Mizoram Co-operative Services Rules, 2007 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules) notified in the Mizoram Gazette Extra-ordinary Issue No. 261 dt. 24.9.2007, namely :-

Short title and Commencement

- (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram State Co-operative Service (Amendment) Rules, 2009
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of publication in the Mizoram Gazette.

Amendment of Rule 5

- Rule 5 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted, namely :-
“**COMPOSITION :**
The service shall have the following Grades, namely :-

<u>Grade</u>	<u>Name of posts</u>
1. Grade-I	Adl. Registrar of Coop. Societies
2. Grade-II	Joint Registrar of Coop. Societies
3. Grade-III	Dy. Registrar of Coop. Societies
4. Grade-IV	Asst. Registrar of Coop. Societies.”

Amendment of Rule 6.

- Rule 6 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted, namely :-
“**CLASSIFICATION**
Members belonging to Grade I to IV mentioned in Rule 5 shall be classified as determined by the Government from time to time.

Amendment of Rule 9.

- In the Principal Rules, for rule 9, the following shall be substituted, namely :-
“**RECRUITMENT TO THE SERVICE**
Recruitment to Grade-IV of the service, after commencement of these rules shall be 75% by promotion and 25% by direct recruitment through Mizoram Public Service Commission in accordance with the conditions laid down by the Government from time to time.”

Amendment of Rule 10.

5. In the Principal Rules, for rule 10, the following rules shall be substituted, namely :-

“CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY FOR CONSIDERING APPOINTMENT.

In order to be eligible for appointment to Grade-IV of the service, a candidate must satisfy the following conditions, namely;

1. **Nationality :** He/She must be a citizen of India.
2. **Method of Recruitment**
 - (a) 75% of vacancies in Grade-IV of the service shall be filled up by promotion from amongst the members of Sr. Inspector/Auditor of Cooperative Societies who have put in not less than 5 years regular service in the grade. The method of recruitment shall be ‘SELECTION’ on the basis of Merit-cum-Seniority.
 - (b) 25% of vacancies in Grade-IV shall be filled up by direct recruitment through open Competitive Examination from graduate of any discipline from a recognized University.

PROMOTION

Grade-I Vacancy in this grade shall be filled by promotion from amongst the members of the service in Grade-II who have rendered at least 5(five) years of regular service in the grade failing which officer on regular service who have rendered 20 years regular service calculated from the date of entry into Grade-IV of the service out of which 2(two) years shall be in Grade-II. The method of promotion to this Grade shall be ‘SELECTION’.

Grade-II Vacancies in this grade shall be filled by promotion from amongst the members of the service in Grade-III who have not less than 5(five) years regular service in the grade failing which officers, who have rendered 15(fifteen) years regular service calculated from the date of entry into Grade-IV of the service out of which 3(three) years shall be in Grade-III. The method of promotion to this grade shall be ‘SELECTION’.

Grade-III. Vacancies in this grade shall be filled by promotion from amongst the members of the service in Grade-IV who have rendered not less than 5(five) years regular service in the grade. The method of promotion to this grade shall be ‘SELECTION’.”

Amendment of Rule 11.

6. In the Principal Rules, for rule 11, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

“APPOINTMENT TO THE SERVICE :

After commencement of these ruels, all appointments to Grade-I to IV of the service shall be made by the Governor through

Mizoram Public Service Commission and notified in the Mizoram Gazette after fulfilling the conditions laid down in rule 10 of these rules.”

- Amendment of Rule 14.* 7. In the Principal Rules for rule 14, the following shall be substituted, namely :-
“**INCREMENT**

The first increment to a member of the service in the time scale of Grade-IV shall accrue on the successful completion of one year.”

- Amendment of Rule 16.* 8. In the Principal Rules for rule 16, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

“**TIME SCALE OF PAY :**

The time scale of pay admissible to the members of the service shall be as follows subject to revision by the Govt. from time to time.

- (1) Grade-I : Rs. 14,300-400-18,300/-plus Rs. 750/-Spl pay
(2) Grade-II : Rs. 14,300-400-18,300/-pm
(3) Grade-III : Rs. 12,000-375-16,500/-pm
(4) Grade-IV : Rs. 10,000-325-15,200/-pm”
