Khawchhakah : Ramri lungphun 3-na aṭangin ramri chuan kawrte a zawh thla a, muthi lui a fin thlengin, tin, Muthi lui a zawh chhuk zel a. Beraw lui nen a inṭin thlengin ; hetah hian ramri lung 4-na phun a ni. Chuta ṭang chuan Berawlui a zawh chhova, Aizawl-Lunglei kawng mel kuaah atan tlang a ; hetah hian ramri lung 5-na phun a ni ; tin, Beraw lui a zawh chho zela, Beraw leh Zckhawsang inkar kawṇ a sut thlengin, Hetah hian ramri lung 6-na phun a ni. Ramri lungphun 6-na atangin Ramri chuan khawthlang lam hawiin Lungbial lui a zawh chhuk a, Chite lui a finna thlengin ; hetah hian ramri lung 7-na phun a ni. Chutichuan Chite lui a zawh chhuk zela Sihpui-lui a fin thlengin ; Hetah hian ramri lung 8 na phun a ni.

Chhimlamah: Ramri lung 8-na aṭangin Sihpui lui a zawh chho leh a, Ngaizel lui zawh chho zelin Aizawl-Thenzawl lamlian a su a; hetah hian ramri lung 9-na phun a ni. Chutichuan Aizawl-Thenzawl lamlian chhim-hawi zawngin a zawh phei a. Saikhama kawṇ Reserve lungphun a su a. Hetah hian ramri Lung 10-na phun a ni; chuta ṭangin ramri chu khawthlang hawi zawngin ngil takin a kal a, Sabual kawṇ Tuikhur a su a; tin, Tuikhur lui (Ramrilui) chu a zawh zela, kawrte Hridaikawṇ (Tlangnuam leh Lungleng in kar ami) a hnar nei nena an in fin thlengin.

Khawthlangah: Ramri chuan Hridaikawṇ kawrte chu a zawh chho a, Hridaikawṇ a su a; hetah hian Ramri lung 11-na phun ani. Chuta ṭangin, Sakhisih peng luite a zawh thla a' Sakhisih a su a; tin Sakhisih a zawh chho leh a. Pu Haiha Huan sir kawrte a su a. Chuta ṭangin kawrte chu a zawh chhova, Pu Laia huan bul Chawlhmun kawṇ a han su a; hetah hian Ramri lung 12-na phun ani. Chutichuan Ramri lung 12-na aṭangin ramri chuan fehkawng hmar-thlang hawiin a zawh phei a. Sedaikawṇ a su a; hetah hian ramri lung 13-na phun a ni. Ramri lung 13-na aṭangin Vailui peng kawrte a zawh chhuk a. Vailui a fin a, tin, Vailui a zawh chhuk zela, Tlawngchai fehkawngin Vailui a kan na thleng in; hetah hian ramri lung 14-na phun ani. Chuta ṭangin ramri chuan fehkawng chu hmar thlang hawi zawngin a zawh phei a, lungphun 14-na aṭanga Kilometre 1¹/₂ thlengin; hetah hian ramri lung 15-na phun a ni. Ramri lung 15-na aṭangin ramri chu ngiltakin a kal a. Kawnzau lui (Luangmual leh Tanhril in kar mi) leh Tuithum in finna a su a; tin, Kawnzau

lui chu a zawh chho va. Luangmual leh Tanhril inkar kawn a su a; hetah hian ramrilung 16-na phun a ni. Chuta tangin mel 5 lui Kawnzau a hnar nei chu a zawh chhuk a, Aizawl-Sairang lamliānin a kanna ah ramri lung 17-na phun a ni. Sairang lui a fin thlengin.

Hmarlamah: Ramri chuan mel 4 Aizawl-Durtlang kawnga hnar nei Sairang lui a zawh chho va, ramri lung 1-na a sut thlengin.

NO .LRR .52/73-74/34-39 Dated Aizawl, the 28th Oct. 1974.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 and 15 of the Mizo District (Land and Revenue) Act. 1956 (Act No.1 of 1957) as adapted by the Government of Mizoram vide Gazette Vol- 111 issue No. 1 of 18/1/74, the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to declare that the area lying within the boundaries specified herein below will be Aizawl Town Area in the Union Territory of Mizoram with immediate effect and until future order and Land Revenue may be assessed as per the Act.

This supercedes the former order in this respect issued by the defunct Mizo District Council vide No. E-3494/C-17 of 1958.-

DESCRIPTION OF AIZAWL TOWN BOUNDARY

Starting Point: Taking the 4th mile stone along Aizawl-Durtlang road as starting point where boundary pillar No. 1 is fixed the boundary runs along the road towards Bungkawn till it meets a stream called

Project lui, the boundary follows up stream of this Lui at a distance of 500 ft. Where boundary pillar No. 2 is fixed ; Thence the boundary runs eastwards at a constant distance of 500 ft parallel to the Aizawl-Lunglei road till it meets Lianzova's land near Kelpuveng where boundary pillar No. 3 is fixed.

Eastern side : From boundary pillar No. 3 the boundary follows down a stream that takes its source from the convoy ground till it meets Muthilui ; thence the boundary runs downstream of Muthilui till it meets Beraw lui where boundary pillar No. 4 is fixed ; thence the boundary runs upstream of Beraw lui crossing Aizawl-Lunglei road at 9 m.p. , where pillar No. 5 is fixed till it meets the saddle between Beraw and Zokhawsang where boundary pillar No. 6 is fixed. From boundary pillar No. 6 the boundary runs downstream of Lungbial lui in westerly direction which takes its source from the saddle till it meets Chitelui where boundary pillar No. 7 is fixed : thence the boundary runs downstream of Chitelui to its confluence with Sihpui lui where boundary pillar No. 8 is fixed.

Southern side ; From boundary pillar No. 8 the boundary runs upstream of Sihpui lui till it meets the stream called Ngaizellui, Thence the boundary follows the Ngaizellui till it meets the Aizawl-Thenzawl road where pillar No. 9 is fixed ; thence the boundary follows the Aizawl-Thenzawl road in southerly direction till it meets Saikhama kawn where (Melthum Viilage) Reserve Boundary pillar was fixed, and where boundary pillar No. 10 is fixed. From Boundary pillar No. 10 the boundary runs in a straight line in Westerly direction upto Sabuakawn water point ; thence the boundary runs downstream of the Tuikhurlui called Ramrilui till it meets a dry stream which takes its source from Hridaikawn on Tlangnuam-Lungleng road.

Western side : Thence the boundary runs upstream of the dry stream till it meets Hridaikawn where boundary pillar No. 11 is fixed ; thence the boundary follows down a nameless stream-let of Sakhisih lui till it meets Sakhi-sih ; thence the boundary runs upstream of Sakhisih till it meets a dry stream called Pu Paiha's huan lui ; thence the boundary runs upsrtteam of this dry stream

till it meets Chawlhmun kawn near Pu Laia's Garden where pillar No. 12 is fixed. From boundary pillar No. 12 the boundary runs along the jhum path of Mission veng in a northwesterly direction till it meets Sedaikawn where boundary pillar No. 13 is fixed. From boundary pillar No. 13 the boundary runs downstream of a streamlet of Vailui till it meets Vailui: thence the boundary runs downstream of Vailui till it meets the point where Tlawngphai jhum road crosses the Vailui where boundary pillar No. 14 is fixed; Thence the boundary runs in northwesterly direction along the jhum path upto a distance of 1½ km. from boundary pillar 14 where boundary pillar No. 15 is fixed; then the boundary line runs in a straight line till it meets the confluence of Tuithum river and Khawzau lui between Luangmual and Tanhril; thence the boundary runs upstream of Kawnzau stream till it meets the saddle between Luangmual and Tanhril road where boundary pillar No. 16 is fixed thence the boundary runs down to Melnga stream which takes its source from the saddle and crosses Sairang road where B.P. No. 17 is fixed till it meets Sairang lui.

Northern side: Thence the boundary runs upstream of Sairang lui, to its source at mile stone No. 4 on Aizawl-Durtlang road, where it meets the boundary pillar No. 1-
