No. MIZ—LA/4/72/2). Whereas the Election Commission is satisfied that Shri Arun Bikash, Sumsilui, B.P.O. Chawngte, Mizoram a contesting candidate for the general election to the Mizoram Legislative Assembly held in April, 1972, from 4 Chawngte constituency, has failed to lodge an account of his election expenses as required by the Representation of the People Act, 1951, and the Rules made thereunder ;

And whereas the said candidate, even after due notices has not given any reason or explanation for the failure and the Election Commission is satisfied that he has no good reason of justification for such failure ;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 10A of the said Act, the Election Commission hereby declares the said Shri Arun Bikash to be disqualified for being chosen as, and for being a member of either house of Parliament or of the Legislative Assembly or Legislative Council of a State for a period of three years from the date of this order.

No. MIZ-LA/4/72 (3) Whereas the Election Commission is satisfied that Shri Roliana, B.P.O.
