**THE MIZORAM APPROPRIATION No. 2 (VOTE ON ACCOUNT) ACT, 2014**

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services for the first four months of the Financial Year, 2014-2015 (i.e. April to July, 2014).

It is enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Sixty Fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

| Short title   | 1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (Vote on Account)Act, 2014  |
| Issue of ` 23810883000/- out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the first four months of the Financial Year, 2014-2015 (i.e. April to July, 2014) | 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied the sums not exceeding those as specified in column (5) of the Schedule to this Act, amounting, in the aggregate, to the sum of <b><i>Rupees two thousand three hundred eighty one crore eight lakh eighty three thousand</i></b> only for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment for the first four months of the Financial Year, 2014-2015 (i.e. April to July, 2014) in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule. |
| Appropriation   | 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.   |
