NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/56/2005-P&AR(GSW), the 3rd February, 2015. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to amend the Mizoram State Cooperative Service Rules, 2007 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules) notified vide No.A.12018/56/2005-P&AR(GSW) dated 19.09.2007 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Extraordinary Issue No. 261 dated the 24.09.2007, as follows, namely:

1. *Short Title and commencement*
 - (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram State Cooperative Service (Amendment) Rules, 2014
 - (2) These Rules shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette

2. *Amendment of Rule 5*

Rule 5 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted as follows, namely,
"COMPOSITION:
The service shall have the following Grades, namely:-

<u>Grade</u>	<u>Name of posts</u>
1. Grade-I	Addl. Registrar of Coop. Societies
2. Grade-II	Joint Registrar of Coop. Societies
3. Grade-III	Deputy Registrar of Coop. Societies
4. Grade-IV	Assistant Registrar of Coop. Societies
5. Grade-V	Senior Inspector/Auditor of Coop. Societies"

3. *Amendment of Rule 6*

Rule 6 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted as follows, namely,
"CLASSIFICATION:
Members belonging to Grade I to IV mentioned in Rule 5 of these Rules shall be classified as Group 'A' Officers and Grade V as Group 'B' Gazetted Officers or as may be determined by the Government from time to time."

4. *Amendment of Rule 9*

Rule 9 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted as follows, namely,
"RECRUITMENT TO THE SERVICE:
Recruitment to Grade-V of the Service, after commencement of these Rules, shall be 40% by promotion, 35% by Limited Departmental Examination (LDE) and 25% by direct recruitment through the Commission in accordance with the conditions laid down by the Government from time to time"

5. *Amendment of Rule 10*

Rule 10 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted, as follows, namely, "CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY FOR CONSIDERING APPOINTMENT:

In order to be eligible for appointment to Grade-V of the service, a candidate must satisfy the following conditions, namely:-

1. Nationality : He/She must be a citizen of India.
2. Method of recruitment:
 - (a) 40% of the sanctioned posts in Grade-V shall be filled up by promotion from Junior Inspector of Cooperative Societies with not less than 5 (five) years of regular service in the grade by Selection method.
 - (b) 35% of the sanctioned posts in Grade-V shall be filled up through Limited Departmental Examination from amongst Junior Inspector of Cooperative Societies with not less than 5 (five) years of regular service in the grade.
 - (c) 25% of the sanctioned posts in Grade-V shall be filled up by direct recruitment through open competitive examination from graduates of recognized University"
3. Promotion:
 - (a) Grade-I: Vacancy in this Grade shall be filled by promotion from members of the service in Grade-II who have rendered not less than 5 (five) years of regular service in the Grade failing which officers on regular service in Grade-II who have completed 25 (twenty five) years of regular service calculated from the date of entry into Grade-V of the service. The method of promotion to this Grade shall be "SELECTION".
 - (b) Grade-II: Vacancies in this Grade shall be filled by promotion from members of the service in Grade-III who have rendered not less than 5 (five) years of regular service in the grade failing which officers on regular service in Grade-III who have completed 20 (twenty) years of regular service calculated from the date of entry into Grade-V of the service. The method of promotion to this grade shall be "SELECTION".
 - (c) Grade-III: Vacancies in this Grade shall be filled by promotion from the members of the service in Grade-IV who have rendered not less than 5 (five) years regular service in the grade. The method of promotion to this Grade shall be "SELECTION".
 - (d) Grade-IV: 75% of the sanctioned posts in this Grade shall be filled by promotion from amongst the members of the service in Grade-V who have rendered not less than 5 (five) years of regular service in the grade by Selection method whereas 25% of the sanctioned posts in this Grade shall be filled through Limited Departmental Examination from amongst the

members of the service in Grade-V who have rendered not less than 5 (five) years of regular service in the grade"

6. *Amendment of Rule 11*

Rule 11 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted as follows, namely,

"APPOINTMENT TO THE SERVICE:

After commencement of these rules, all appointments to Grade-I to Grade-V of the service shall be made by the Governor through the Commission and notified in the Mizoram Gazette after fulfilling the conditions laid down in Rule 10 of these rules"

7. *Amendment of Rule 12*

Rule 12 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted as follows, namely,

"PROBATION AND CONFIRMATION:

(1) A person appointed to the Service by direct recruitment shall be on probation for a period of 2 (two) years, which may be extended for good and sufficient reasons by the Government for a further period as may be determined by the Government.

(2) Where a probationer has successfully completed his/her probation period or any extension thereof to the satisfaction of the Appointing Authority, he/she may be confirmed in service.

(3) If during the period of probation referred to in sub-rule (1) and sub-rule (2), as the case may be, the Appointing Authority is of the opinion that an Officer is not fit for regular appointment, he/she may, in consultation with the Commission through DP&AR, discharge the Officer from Service or pass an order as deemed fit

Provided that a person who has been already confirmed in any of the posts under the State Government before being appointed as a member of the Service shall be deemed to have been confirmed in Service"

8. *Amendment of Rule 14*

Rule 14 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted as follows, namely,

"INCREMENT:

The first increment of pay in the time scale of pay in respect of a member of the Service in Grade-V appointed by direct recruitment shall accrue on confirmation in the Service and the increment shall be regulated in accordance with Government of India's Decision No. (6) and Audit instruction No. (4) below Rule 26 of Fundamental Rules"

9. *Amendment of Rule 16*

Rule 16 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted as follows, namely,

"TIME SCALE OF PAY:

The time scale of pay admissible to the members of the service shall be as follows subject to revision by the Govt. from time to time

- (1) Grade-I : PB-4 : ^ 37,400-67,000 + ^ 8700 GP
 (2) Grade-II : PB-3 : ^ 15,600-39,100 + ^ 7600 GP
 (3) Grade-III : PB-3 : ^ 15,600-39,100 + ^ 6600 GP
 (4) Grade-IV : PB-3 : ^ 15,600-39,100 + ^ 5400 GP
 (5) Grade-V : PB-2 : ^ 9,300-34,800 + ^ 4400 GP

10. *Amendment of Schedule*

In the Principal Rules, the Schedule shall be substituted as follows, namely,
