NOTIFICATION

MC.4/15/72 : Whereas the Administrator of Mizoram, after careful consideration of all facts and circumstances, is of opinion that the whole area of the Union Territory of Mizoram is in such disturbed and dangerous condition that use of Armed Force in aid of the civil power is necessary;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act, 1958, the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to declare the whole of Mizoram as disturbed area within the meaning and for the purpose of the said Act for a period of six months.

No. EXC. 24/74/74, the 20th Feb., 76. The Lt. Governor of Mizoram is pleased to order that all the Security Forces posted in Mizoram including the civilians shall be exempted from payment of Excise duty for import of all kinds of India-Made Foreign Liquor including Rum and Beer into Mizoram. However, all the Security forces including the civilians shall pay a pass fee at the rates of Rs. 1.50p per bottle (750 ml) on all kinds of India-Made Foreign Liquor including Rum and Re 0.40p per bottle of Beer. The Pass fee for overseas foreign liquor shall be Rs. 3.00 per bottle of 750ml.

This order shall be in force with immediate effect and shall continue to be in force until further orders or till the enforcement of the Mizoram Excise Act, 1973 whichever is earlier.
