THE INCOME-TAX (AMENTMENT) ACT, 1976

AN ACT

further to amend the Income-tax Act, 1961. Be it enacted by Parliament in the Twenty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be called the Income-tax (Amend- Short title and ment) Act, 1976.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 9th day of September, 1975.

THE APPRORIATION (RAILWAYS) ACT, 1976

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of India for the services of the financial year 1975-76 for the purposes of Railways.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Twenty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows :----

1. This Act may be called the Appropriation (Railways) Act, She 1975.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of India there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of eighteen lakhs and thirty thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1975-76, in respect of the services relating to railways specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of India by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
