S.O. Whereas the House of the People was dissolved by the President under sub-clause (b) of clause (2) of article 85 of the Constitution on the 18th January, 1977;

AND whereas a general election has to be held for the purpose of constituting a new House;

NOW, therefore, in pursuance of sub-section (2) of section 14 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the President is hereby pleased to call upon all the parliamentary constituencies to elect members in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder.

S.O. Whereas the President of India has, by notification published in the Gazette of India on 10 February, 1977, called upon all Parliamentary Constituencies to elect members to the House of the People;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 30 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Election Commission hereby appoints:-

(i) with respect of each of the said elections:-

- (a) 17 February, 1977 (Thursday), as the last date for making nominations;
- (b) 18 February, 1977 (Friday), as the date for the scrutiny of nominations;
- (c) 21 February, 1977 (Monday), as the last date for withdrawal of candidatures; and
- (d) 22 March, 1977 (Tuesday), as the date before which the election shall be completed.

(ii) for each State specified in the Schedule below, with respect to the election by any Parliamentary Constituency specified in column 1 below, the date or dates specified against it in column 2 thereof as the date or dates on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken in that constituency or in the area comprised within the Assembly Constituency specified in column 3 against each of the dates.

- 1) An election is to be held of a member to the House of the People in the Mizoram Parliamentary constituency;
