Ministry of Labour, New Delhi under letter No. R. 11012 (14)-/76-PF II dated 14th March, 1977 is hereby republished for general information. G.S.R., In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5, read with sub-section (1) of section 7, of the Employees' Provident Funds and Misochancous Provisions Act, 1952 (19 of 1952), the Central Government hereb/ makes the following Scheme further to smend the Employees' Provident Funds Scheme, 1952, eamely:--

- 1. (1) This Scheme may be called the Employees' Provident Funds (Second Amendment) Scheme, 1977.
 - It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
- In paragraph 72, -
 - (a) in sub paragraph (i), +
 - (i) after the expression "in case there is no nominet in accordance with the Scheme", the expression "of there is no person entitled to receive such amount under sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph 70" shall be inserted:
 - (ii) for the expression "Rupees 5,000" the expression "Rupees 1,000 shall be substituted:
 - (b) in sub-paragraph (3), -
 - (i) for the expression "where the amount does not exceed Rupees 5,000 or the Chairman of the Central Board, if the amount exceeds Rupees 5,000 but does not exceeds Rupees 10,000", the expression "where the amount does not exceed Rupees 10,000 or the Chairman of the Central Board, if the amount exceeds rupees 10,000" shall be substituted;
 - (ii) the last sentence begining with the words "In any other case" and coding with the words "on behalf of the minor" shall be omitted.
 - (c) in sub-paragraph (3A), +
 - (i) for the expression "where the amount does not exceed Rupees 5,000 or the Chairman of the Central Board. if the amount exceeds Rupees 5,000 but does not exceed Rupees 10,000", the expression "where the amount does not exceed Rupees 10,000 or the Chairman."
