to authorise the appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram for the service of the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 1977.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the twenty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 1977.

2. The Government of the Union Territory of Mizoram may appropriate from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram, for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 1977, a sum not exceeding forty-six crores, sixty-four lakhs and eighty-four thousand rupees, being moneys required to meet, —
