No. LID 17/77/3, the 29th March, 1977. The following Act passed by the Mizoram Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Lt Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is hereby published for general information.

The Mizoram Act No. 5 of 1977. (The Mizoram Appropriation (No. I) Act 1977) Received the assent of the Lt. Governor (Administrator) Mizoram on 28th March, 1977.

#### AN ACT

to authorise the appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizaram for the service of the financial year which commenced on the 1st April, 1976.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. I) Act, 1977. Short Title.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the (wepty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

 This Act may be called the Misoram Appropriation (No. 2). Act. 1977.

Short title.

2. The Government of the Union Territory of Mizoram may appropriate from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram, for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 1977, a sum not exceeding forty-six crores, sixty-four lakhs and eighty-four thousand rupees, being moneys required to moot, -
