#### NOTIFICATON

No.LAD/A-9/76/136: the 12th April, 1977. WHEREAS by an order published in the Government's Notification No. LAD/A-9/76/45, dated the 27 September 1976, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram has assumed to himself all the executive, financial and administrative functions and powers vested in or exercisable by the Chakma District Council for a period of six months with effect from the forenoon of 15th October, 1976, except the powers of the District Council to make laws under paragraph 3 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India:

AND WHEREAS, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoran is satisfied that there are sufficient grounds for the extention of the operation of the initial order for a further period of six months;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 16 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is pleased to extend the operation of the said initial order for a further period of six months from the forenoon of 15th April, 1977.

Basappa Danappa Jatti, Vice President acting as President of India, hereby revoke the Proclamation of Emergency issued under clause (1) of that article on the 25th June, 1975, and published with the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Home Affairs No. GSR 353(E) dated the 26th June, 1975.
