NOTIFICATION

[S.O. 324 (E), the 11th May, 1977. The following Order made by the Vice President acting as President is published for general information:—

ORDER

WHEREAS I, Basappa Danappa Jatti, Vice President acting as President of India, have received a report from the Administrator of the Union Territory of Mizoram and after considering the report, I am satisfied that a situation has arisen in which the administration of the Union Territory of Mizoram cannot be carried on in accordance with the provisions of the Government of Union Territories Act, 1963 (20 of 1963) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act");

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 51 of the Act and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf. I hereby —

(a) Suspend, for a period of seven months from the date of this order, in relation to the said Union Territory of Mizoram, the operation of the following provisions of the Act, namely:—
section 6 :

in section 7, sub sections (1), (3) and 4, clauses (b) and (c) of sub-section (2) and the first proviso to that sub-section, and so much of sub-section (5) as relates to the Salaries and allowances of the Deputy Speaker :

sections 8 to 12 (both inclusive), sections 15 to 17 (both inclusive), section 22 and section 24 ;

so much of sub-section (1) of section 27 as requires the previous approval of the President and so much of clause (c) of sub-section (3) of the same section as relates to the salaries and allowances of the Deputy Speaker.

so much of sub-section (1) of section 30 as requires the previous approval of the President ;

section 33, sub-section (2) of section 34 and section 36 :

section 44 and 45 :

Sub-section (1) and the following provision, namely, "whether taken on the advice of his Ministers or otherwise" in sub-section (2) of section 46: and so much of section 50 as relates to the Council of Ministers : and

(b) make the following incidental and consequential provisions which appear to me to be necessary and expedient for administering the Union territory of Mizoram in accordance with the provisions of article 239 of the Constitution during the aforesaid period, namely :—

- (i) in relation to the said Union Territory, unless the context otherwise require, any reference in section 23, 27, 28, 30 and 49 of the Act to the Administrator shall be construed as a reference to the President and any reference in section 23, 27, to 31 (both inclusive) 48 and 49 to the Legislative Assembly of a Union Territory in whatever form of words shall in so far as it relates to the functions and powers thereof, be construed as a reference to Parliament :
- (ii) in relation to the said Union Territory, the reference to the Legislative Assembly of a Union Territory in section 26 shall be construed as including a reference to Parliament.

In TABLE 3 of the said notification :—

- (i) against item No 4 Gujarat, under column 2 the entries “(5) Cultivator winnowing grain” and “(10) Plough” shall be DELETED and the remaining entries Nos. (6) to (9) shall be renumbered as (5) to (8) and the entries at Nos. (11) to (18) shall be renumbered as (9) to (16);
- (ii) against item No. 5 Haryana, under column 2, the entry “(7) Plough” shall be DELETED and the remaining entries Nos. (8) to (10) shall be numbered as (7) to (9);
- (iii) against item No. Himachal Pradesh under column 2, the entry “(3) Farmer winnowing grain” shall be DELETED and the remaining entries Nos (4) to (9) shall be renumbered as (3) to (8);
- (iv) against item No. 10 Madhya Pradesh under column 2, the entry “(3) Cultivator winnowing grain” shall be DELETED and the remaining entries Nos. (4) to (12) shall be renumbered as (3) to (11);
- (v) against item No. 22 West Bengal, under column 2, the entry “(15) Plough” shall be DELETED and the remaining entries Nos. (16) to (25) shall be renumbered as (15) to (24);
- (vi) against item No. 24. Arunachal Pradesh, under column 2, the entries “(8) Mithun, (9) Plough” and “(11) Rising Sun” shall be DELETED and the entry at S. No. (10) shall be renumbered as (8) and entries at S. Nos. (12) to (16) shall be renumbered as (9) to (13).

NOTIFICATION

S.O. Whereas by its order dated 11 May, 1977 under paragraph 16 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, the Election Commis-

sion has decided that the Janata Party formed as a result of the amalgamation of four National Parties, namely, 1. Indian National Congress (Organisation), 2. Bharatiya Jana Sangh, 3. Bharatiya Lok Dal and 4. Socialist Party, shall be a National Party and that the symbol "Haldhar within wheel (Chakra Haldhar)" shall be reserved for it;

And whereas the Commission has further decided in the said order that the name of the four National Parties, namely 1. Indian National Congress (Organisation), 2. Bharatiya Jana Sangh, 3. Bharatiya Lok Dal and 4. Socialist Party should be deleted from the list of National Parties and that the reserved symbols 1. "Charkha being plied by a woman", 2. "Lamp" and 3. "Tree", should be frozen;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of clause (a) of sub-paragraph (1) and sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 17 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and allotment) Order, 1968 the Commission hereby makes the following amendments to its notification No. 56/77-II, dated 9 February, 1977, published as S.O. 152 (E) in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, part II, section 3 (ii), dated 9 February, 1977, and as amended from time to time, namely—

ELECTION COMMISSION OF INDIA

PRESS NOTE

The Election Commission has decided under the provisions of paragraph 16 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, that four national parties, namely, 1. Indian National Congress (Organisation), 2. Bharatiya Jana Sangh, 3. Socialist Party and 4. Bharatiya Lok Dal have merged to form a new political party by name "Janata Party" and consequently have ceased to exist as separate parties for the purpose of the said order. The symbols "Char-ha being plied by a woman" reserved for India National Congress (Organisation) "Lamp" reserved for Bharatiya Jana Sangh and "Tree" reserved for Socialist Party have also been forzen by the Commission.

The Commission has recognised the Janata Party as a National Party with the reserved symbol "Haldhar within wheel (Chakra Haldhar)".

The Commission issued as Order and notification to this effect today.
