REGULATION NO. I OF 1977

THE LAKHER DISTRICT (MARKET) REGULATION, 1977. (Received the assent of the Administrator of Mizoram on the 9th July 1977)

A REGULATION

to provide for the management and control of markets within the Lakher District

Whereas it is necessary to make provisions for the establishment, management and control of market and to levy and collect tolls therein in the Lakher Autonomous District.

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (a) This regulation may be called the Lakher District (Market) Regulation, 1977.
- (b) It extends to the whole of the Lakher Autonomous District.
- (c) It shall come into force at once.

2. In this Regulation unless there is any thing repugnant to the context:—
- (a) "District" means the Laker Autonomous District.
 - (b) "District Council" means the District Council of the Laker Autonomous District and the term "Executive Committee" and "Chief Executive Member" shall be construed accordingly.
 - (c) "lessee" means settlement holder of a market for a specified period ordinarily not exceeding one year.
 - (d) "market" means an appointed place where people came together to buy and sell foodstuffs and other commodities.
 - (e) "prescribed" means prescribed by Rules made under this Regulation.
3. All markets within the District shall be under the control of the District Council.
4. No person shall, without the previous approval of the District Council, start any new market.
5. The District Council shall have power to levy tolls, taxes and other revenue which it is competent to levy in any market within the District according to the rates as prescribed in consideration of the Locality of the market.
6. The Executive Committee may, if found necessary for the better management of the market, settle any market in Public auction for a lease of a specific period
7. In case section 6 is in operation, the successful bidder will have to pay one third of the amount of his bid on the spot and the balance within 7 (seven) days from the date of his bid being accepted.
8. The Executive Committee shall have power—
- (a) to sanction the establishment of any markets ;
 - (b) to fix the market day or days in a week for all or any of the markets ;
 - (c) to close any market in the public interest, if it is found necessary.
9. (1) Subject to the provisions of sub-section (e) of section 2, the Executive Committee may make rules for carrying out the purpose of this regulation.
- (2) In particular and without prejudices to the generality of the foregoing powers such rules may provide for—
- (a) the management of the markets ;
 - (b) the fixation of tolls, taxes or revenues leviable in a market
 - (c) the collections and credit of all tolls and revenues due to the District council ;
 - (d) the terms and condition of the lease or agreement between the Executive Committee and the lessee.]
