NOTIFICATIONS

ON. LAD/A-19/77/47, the 3rd November, 1977. Whereas by Notification No. LAD/A-19/77/46 dated the 2nd November, 1977 issued under sub-rule (2) of rule 125 of Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules, 1974 published in Mizoram Gazette Extra-ordinary on the 3rd November, 1977, every constituency in the Laker and Chakma Autonomous Districts was called upon to elect a member for constituting the new District Councils:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (2) of rule 134 of the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules, 1974, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is pleased to appoint with respect to the said election :-

- (a) The 19th November, 1977 as the last date for making nominations;
- (b) The 21st November, 1977 as the date for scrutiny of nominations;
- (c) The 12th December, 1977 as the date on which poll shall, if necessary, be taken;
- (d) The 30th December, 1977 as the date before which the elections shall be completed.
