### NOTIFICATION

S. O. - Whereas in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph 6 read with paragraph 7 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) order, 1968, the Election Commission of India has reviewed the poll performance of various political parties on the basis of the results of the General Elections to the House of the People, and some State Legislative Assemblies held in March, May-June and November 1977;

And whereas, as a result of the said review the Commission has decided to recognise new political parties and to de-recognise some State Parties;

And whereas the Commission has also decided upon the addition/deletion of some of the existing free symbols after giving a reasonable opportunity to all the recognised and registered political parties to express their views in the matter;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of clauses (a), (b) and (d) of sub-paragraph (1) and sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 17 of the Order referred to above and in supersession of its Notification No. 56/77-II, dated 9 February, 1977 published as S.O.152(E) in the Gazette of India . Extraordinary, Part II, section 3(ii) dated 9 February, 1977, the election Commission hereby specifies :-

- (a) the National Parties and the symbols respectively reserved for them in Table 1;
- (b) the State Parties, the State or States in which they are State Parties and the symbols respectively reserved for them in such State or States in Table 2; and
- (c) the free symbols for each State in Table 3.
