## NOTIFICATION

No. LJD. 10/78/44, the 28th April, 1978. The Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. GSR 1716, dated 12.12.1977 is hereby republished for general information.

“The Commissions of Enquiry (Central) Amendment Rules, 1977.”

G.S.R.1716:— In exercise of the powers conferred by section 12 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952 (60 of 1952), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules, 1972, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Commissions of Inquiry (Central) Amendment Rules, 1977.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In rule 5 of the Commissions of Inquiry (Central) Rules, 1972, in sub-rule (5), for clause (b) the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(b) If after all the evidence is recorded under clause (a), the Commission is satisfied that it is necessary for the proper determination of any relevant fact to do so, it may recall any witness already examined or examine any new witness.”
