NOTIFICATIONS

No. LJD. 40/77/VOL-II/132, the 20th June, 1978. The Lt. Governor (Administrator) of the Union Territory of Mizoram is pleased to make the following amendment to the Rules relating to the duties, fees etc. of the Standing Counsel, Government of Mizoram, published with Notification No. LJD. 93/74/79, dated the 1st October, 1975, in the Mizoram Gazette Extraordinary, dated the 1st October, 1975, namely :—

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, for rule 6 ; the following rule shall be substituted, namely :—

“Fee to Standing Counsel. (1) The Standing Counsel shall be allowed a daily fee as follows :—

Civil Cases —

- (a) First Appeals Rs. 85/-
- (b) Other matters Rs. 51/-
- (c) Matters relating to Articles
226-228 of the Constitution Rs. 85/-
- (d) Tax Cases Rs. 100/-

CRIMINAL CASES.

- (a) Appeals and Jury references. Rs. 85/-
- (b) Other matters. Rs. 51/-

REVENUE CASES.

Revenue appeals and other matters. Rs. 34/-

(2) For any day on which he appears only in a case or appeal which is adjourned without hearing, he shall be entitled to a fee amounting to only half of that fixed for such case or appeal under this rule. If he appears before the High Court in more than one case in a day, he will be entitled to get the highest daily fee fixed for any of those cases. No fee shall be admissible for appearance on a day when only judgement is delivered.

(3) The Standing Counsel shall be allowed filing fee for preparation and filing of documents such as affidavit, counter affidavit, memorandum of appeal, revision petition, at the rate of Rs. 50/— in each case in addition to, and independent of, the daily fee allowed under sub—rules (1) and (2). No fee will be allowed for the preparation and filing of any other subsidiary documents in that case

Note:— For submission of petition to the High Court for adding the Administrator, Union of India as a party, the Standing Counsel will be entitled to a fee of Rs. 40/—”.

further to amend the Constitution of India Be it enacted by Parliament in the Twenty—eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Constitution (Amendment) Act, 1977. Short title and commencement.
- (2) It shall come into force at once.
5. 2. In article 51 of the Constitution, after clause (d), the following clause shall be inserted, namely: Amendment of article 51.
- “(e) collaborate with other nations for the early formation of a World Constituent Assembly to draft the Constitution for a World Federal Government.”

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The time is opportune, nay ripe, for all good men and good governments of the world to get together and make earnest efforts for convening a World Constituent Assembly as a preparatory step towards the establishment of a Parliament of Man and Federation of the World, War cannot be abolished, nor can a warm living peace descend on earth, unless such a world order based on world Law is firmly founded.

Hence this Bill.

EXTRACT FROM THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

51. The State shall endeavour to - Promotion of international peace and security.
- (a) promote international peace and security;
- (b) maintain just and honourable relations between nations;
- (c) foster respect for international law and treaty obligations in the dealings of organised peoples with one another; and
- (d) encourage settlement of international disputes by arbitration.
