Mizoram Act No 1 of 1978

The Mizoram Appropriation Act, 1978

(Received the assent of the Lt. Governor (Administrator)  
of Mizoram on 17th July, 1978.)

AN  
ACT

to authorise the appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram for the services of the financial year 1978—79.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation Act, Short title: 1978.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate (inclusive of the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to the Mizoram Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 1978 (Central Act 9 of 1978) to the sum of fifty-six crores, twenty-two lakhs and eighty-one thousand rupees, towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1978-79 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

Issue of Rupees 56,22,81,000/- from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram for the Financial Year, 1978-79.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
