NOTIFICATION

ELECTION COMMISSION OF INDIA

New Delhi, Dated 29 February, 1980. Phalguna 10, 1901 (Saka.)

S.O. Whereas the Election Commission is satisfied that a result of its poll performance at the general election to the Legislative Assembly of Sikkim held in October, 1979, the Sikkim Prajatantra Congress which is a registered unrecognised political party is entitled for recognition as a State Party in the State of Sikkim in terms of paragraph 6 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) order, 1968;

And whereas the Commission has decided to recognise the Sikkim Prajatantra Gongress as a State Party in the State of Sikkim, and reserve the symbol 'Ladder' for the said party in Sikkim;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of clause (b) and clause (c) of sub-paragraph (1) and sub-paragraph (2) of paragsaph 17 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and allotment) Order, 1968, the Election Commission hereby mades the following amendments in its notification No. 56/79, dated 28 September, 1979 published as S.O. 557 (E) in the Gazette of India, Cxtraordinary, Part II, Section 3 (ii) dated 28 September, 1979, and as amended from time to time, namely—

- (1) In TABLE 2 of the said notification, in the enriries ralating to Sikkim, under columns 2 and 3.
 - (a) the entry "4. Sikkim Prajatantra Congress...... Ladder" shall be inserted; and
- (2) In TABLE 3 of the said notification, under columns 1 and 2.
 - (a) the entry "12 Sikkim Prajatantra Congress.... Sikkim" shall be deleted; and (b) the existing entry No. 13 shall be renumbered as No. 12.
