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NOTIFICATION

No. GAD. 322/78/4-64, the 14 September, 1978. In exercise of the powers conferred by section 30 of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 (Act 18 of 1969) the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of the Union Territory of Mizoram, with the approval of the Central Government, hereby makes the following rules, namely :—

- Short title and Extent
1. (i) These rules may be called the Mizoram Registration of Births and Deaths Rules, 1978.
 - (ii) These rules extend to the whole of the Union Territory of Mizoram.
 - (iii) These shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Mizoram Gazette.

- Definitions.
2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires :—
 - (a) "Act" means the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 (Act 18 of 1969)
 - (b) "Administrator" means the Administrator of the Union Territory of Mizoram ;
 - (c) 'Form' means a form appended to these rules,
 - (d) 'section' means a section of the Act.
 - (e) 'Town' means district headquarters and such other places having a population of 10,000 and above.

Period of ges- 3. The period of gestation for the purposes of clause (g) of
tation under section 2(1)(g) sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Act shall be twenty eight weeks.

Submission of report 4. The report under sub-section (4) of section 4 shall be prepared under section 4 (4) in Form No. 1 and shall be submitted alongwith the statistical report referred to in sub-section (2) of section 19 to the Administrator by the Chief Registrar every year by the 31st July of the year following the year to which the report relate.

Form etc. for giving in- 5. (1) The information required to be given to the Registrar formation of births and deaths under sections 8 and 9 (1) shall be given :-

(a) IN A TOWN OR CANTONMENT

- (i) within seven days from the date of live birth or still birth,
- (ii) within three days from the date of death.

(b) IN ANY OTHER AREA

- (i) within twenty one days from the date of live birth or still birth,
- (ii) and within ten days from the date of death.

Birth or death in a vehicle under section 8 (1)(f) 6. (i) In respect of a birth or death in moving vehicle, the person incharge of the vehicle shall give or cause to be given the information under sub-section (1) of section 8 at the first place of half.

EXPLANATION :- For the purpose of this rule, the term 'vehicle' means conveyance of any kind used on land, air or water and includes an aircraft, a boat, a ship, a railway carriage, a motor car, a motorcycle, a cart, a tonga and a rikshaw.

(ii) In the case of deaths (not falling under clause (a) to (e) of sub-section (1) of section 8 in which an inquest is held, the officer who conducts the Inquest shall give or cause to be given the information under sub-section (1) of section 8.

Time and Form for notifying in- 7. (1) Every person required to notify a live birth, still birth of formation under section 10 (1) death under section 10 shall give information thereof to the Registrar in Form nos. 5, 6 or 7 as the case may be,

- (2) Such information shall be given —
- (a) **IN A TOWN OR CANTONMENT**
- (i) within seven days from the date of live birth or still birth; and
- (ii) within three days from the date of death,
- (b) **IN ANY OTHER AREA**
- (i) within twenty one days from the date of live birth or still birth; and
- (ii) within ten days from the date of death.

Form of Certificate under section 10 (3) 8. The certificate as to the cause of death required under sub-section (3) of section 10 shall be issued in Form No. 8 and the Registrar shall, after making necessary entries in the Register of Birth and Deaths, forward all such certificates to the Chief Registrar or the officer specified by him in this behalf by the 10 of the month immediately following the month to which the certificates relate.

Extract of registration entries to be given under section 12 9. The extracts of particulars from the register relating to Births or deaths to be given to an informant under section 12 shall be in Form No. 9 or Form No. 10, as the case may be.

Authority for delayed registration and thereof under section 13 10. (1) Any birth or death of which information is given to the Registrar after the expiry of the period specified in rule, 5, but within thirty days of its occurrence, shall be registered on payment of a late fee of one rupee.

(2) Any birth or death of which information is given to the Registrar after thirty days but within one year of its occurrence, shall be registered only with the written permission of the officer specified the Administrator in this behalf and on payment of a late fee of three rupees.

(3) Any birth or death which has not been registered within one year of its occurrence shall be registered only on an order of a magistrate of the first Class and on payment of a late fee of five rupees.

Period for the purpose of section 14 11. (1) Where the live birth of any child had been registered without a name, the parent or guardian of such child shall within twelve months from the date of registration of the birth of child, give information regarding the name of the child, to the Registrar either orally or in writing. Provided that if any such information is given after the period of twelve months, subject to the provision of sub-section (4) of section 23, the Registrar shall,

(a) If the register is in his possession, forthwith enter the name in the register on payment of a late fee of two rupees.

(b) If the register is not in his possession and if the information is given orally, make a report giving necessary particulars, and if the information is given in writing, forward the name to the officer specified by the Administrator in this behalf for making the necessary entry on payment of a late fee of two rupees.

(2) The parent or the guardian as the case may be shall also present to the Registrar the copy of the extract given to him under section 12 or a certified extract issued to him under section 17, and on such presentation the Registrar shall make the necessary endorsement relating to the name of the child or take action as laid down in clause (b) of the proviso to sub-rule (1).

Correction or cancellation of entry in the register of births and Deaths under section 15

12. (1) If it is reported to the Register that a clerical or formal error has been made in the register or if such error is otherwise noticed by him and if the register is in his possession, the Registrar shall enquire into the matter and if he is satisfied that any such error has been made, he shall correct the error (by correcting or cancelling the entry) as provided in section 15 and shall send an extract of the entry showing the error and how it has been corrected, to the Administrator of the officer specified by him in this behalf.

(2) In the case referred to in sub-rule (1) if the register is not in his possession, the Registrar shall make a report to the Administrator or the officer specified by him in this behalf, and call for relevant register and after enquiring into the matter if he is satisfied that any such error has been made, make the necessary correction.

(3) Any such correction as mentioned in sub-rule (2) shall be countersigned by the Administrator or the officer specified by him in this behalf when the register is received from the Registrar.

(4) If any person asserts that any entry in the register of births and deaths is erroneous in substance, the Registrar may correct the entry in the manner prescribed under section 15 upon production by that person a declaration setting forth the nature of the error and true facts of the case made by two creditable persons having knowledge of the facts of the case.

(5) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1) and sub-rule (4), the Registrar shall make report of any correction of the kind referred to therein giving necessary details to the administrator or the officer specified in this behalf.

(6) If it is proved to the satisfaction of the Registrar that any entry in the register of births and deaths has been fraudulently or improperly made, he shall make a report giving necessary details to the officer authorised by the Chief Registrar by general or special orders in this behalf under section 25 and on hearing from him take necessary action in the matter.

(7) In every case in which an entry is corrected or cancelled under this rule, intimation thereof should be sent to the permanent address of the person who has given information, under section 8 or section 9.

Form of register under section 16

13. (1) The register of live births, still births and deaths to be kept by the Registrar under section 16 shall be in three parts as set out in Form nos, 11, 12 and 13 respectively and in each part of the register, the event shall be numbered serially and for each calendar year.

(2) A new register shall be opened on the 1st day of January of each year.

(3) An event which occurred in any previous year shall be recorded in the register for the year in which it is reported. Provided that no entry shall be interpolated between two entries recorded earlier.

Fees and postal charges payable under section 17

14. (1) The fees payable for a search to be made or an extract to be issued under section 17 shall be as follows:

(a) search for a single entry in the first year for which the search is made, one rupee;

(b) for every additional year for which the search is continued one rupee;

(c) for granting extract relating to each birth and death, one rupee.

(2) Any such extract in regard to a birth or death shall be issued by the Registrar or the officer authorised by the Administrator in this behalf in Form No. 9 or Form no 10 as the case may be and shall be certified in the manner provided for in section 76 of Indian Evidence Act, 1872.

(3) Any such extract may be furnished to the person asking for it by post on payment of postal charges therefor.

Interval and 15. (1) Every Registrar including the Registrar for town shall send Forms of periodical returns on or before the 5th of each month, a true copy of the entries in turns under the register of births and deaths relating to the month immediately preceding, section 19(1).

(2) The officer so specified shall forward all such copies of the entries in the register of births and deaths received by him to the Chief Registrar not later than the 10th of that month.

(3) The Registrar for the town shall send to the Chief Registrar in Form No. 14 a weekly return of births and deaths within seven days of the expiry of the week to which the information relates and in Form No. 15 a monthly return of births and deaths by the end of the month following the month to which the information relates.

(4) The Registrar for a Cantonment shall send to the Chief Registrar or the officer specified by the Chief Registrar in this behalf, a weekly return of births and deaths in Form No. 14 within four days of the expiry of the week to which the information relates and a monthly return of births and deaths in Form No. 15 by the end of the month following the month to which the information relates.

Statistical report under section 19(2) 16. Statistical report under sub-section (2) of section 19 shall be in Form No. 16 and shall be compiled for each year before the 31st July of the year immediately following and shall be published as soon as may be there-after but in any case not later than five months from that date.

Conditions for compounding offences under section 23. 17. (1) Any offence punishable under section 23 may either before or after the institution of original proceedings under this Act, be compounded by an officer authorised by the Chief Registrar by a general or special order in this behalf, if the officer so authorised is satisfied that the offence was committed through inadvertence or oversight or for the first time.

(2) Any such offence may be compounded on payment of such sum not exceeding fifty rupees for offences under sub-section (1), (2) and (3) of section 23 and ten rupees for offences under sub-section (4) of section 23 as the said officer may think fit.

Registers and other records under section 30 (2) (k) 18. (1) The register of births and deaths shall be a record of permanent importance and shall not be destroyed.

(2) All information received by the Registrar under sections 8 and 9 and the certificates as to the cause of deaths furnished under

sub-section (3) of section 10 of the Act shall form an integral part of the register of births and deaths and shall not be destroyed.

(3) Every register of births and deaths and the forms relating to the entries therein shall be retained by the Registrar in his possession for a period of twelve months after the end of the calendar year to which it relates and such register forms shall thereafter be transferred for safe custody to such officer as may be specified by the administrator in this behalf.
