### RULES FOR ALLOCATION OF SEATS AND AWARDED STIPENDS FOR SURVEY TRAINING COURSE FROM MIZORAM

In exercise of powers conferred under Rule 20 the D.F.P. Rules, 1978 the Lieut. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules for allotment of seats and granting of stipend to the students intending to take up technical studies in Survey Training Course in Government recognised institution in India.

1. (a) These Rules may be called "The Mizoram, Revenue allocation of seats and grant of Stipend for Survey Training Rules, 1979".  
  
(b) It shall come into force with effect from such date as the Administrator may, by Notification in the official Gazette appoint.
2. In these Rules unless the context otherwise requires :
  - (a) "Administrator" means the Administrator of the Union Territory of Mizoram.
  - (b) "Government" means the Government of Union Territory of Mizoram.
  - (c) "Department" means the Revenue, Excise & Taxation Department, Government of Mizoram.

Whereas by notification No. LAD/-A 19/77/Pt/301 dated the 18th, June, 1980 issued under Sub-rule (1) of rule 127 of the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules, 1974, published in the Mizoram Gazette extra ordinary on the 18th June, 1980 the Jarulsury Constituency in the Chakma Autonomous District was called upon to elect a person to fill the vacancy in the said constituency.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-rule (2) of rule 134 of the Mizoram Autonomous District Councils (Constitution and Conduct of Business of the District Councils) Rules, 1974, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of the Union Territory of Mizoram is pleased to appoint with respect of the said election :—

- (a) 3 p.m. on 8th July, 1980 as the last date for making nominations;
- (b) 3 p.m. on 8th July, 1980 as the date for Scrutiny of nominations;
- (c) 9th July, 1980 as the date on which scrutiny of nominations may continue if necessary;
- (d) 17th July, 1980 as the date on which poll shall, if necessary taken ; and
- (e) 22nd July, 1980 as the date before which the election shall be completed.

nistrator may stop or withheld further payment of the stipend for such period as it may think fit.

- (d) If a candidate is found to have obtained a stipend by false statements, his/her stipend will be cancelled forthwith and the amount paid will be recovered at the descretion of the Administrator.
- (e) A stipend may be stopped if the stipend holder changes the subjects of the course of study for which the stipend was originally granted or changes the Institution of study without the prior approval of the Administrator. The Head of the Institution shall report such cases to the Government and stop payment of the stipend amount. The amount paid may also be recovered at the discretion of the Administrator.

Application for admission to the institution for studies shall be invited by the Director, Land Revenue and Settlement from the intending student by Advertisement giving reasonable time prior to the commencement of academic sessions as may be deemed suitable and proper in the form of application as may be prescribed, with other necessary particulars.

Scrutiny by 6.  
the Selection

- (a) On expiry of the last date of sub-mission of applications by the student for allocation of seats and for stipends the Director, Land Revenue & Settlement shall prepare a statement of all applications with detailed particulars in terms of advertisement and shall forward the statement so prepared along with such applications received to the Secretary to the Government of Mizoram of the Department concerned within the time limit as may be fixed by the Department.
- (b) On receipt of applications from the Director as stated in 6 (a) above, the Secretary to the Government of Mizoram shall convene the meeting of the selection Board to be constituted by the Administrator with the following members for scrutiny and final allocation of seats reserved Government of India from time to time under different institutions for Union Territory of Mizoram and in accordance with the criteria laid down by the Government of India, grant stipend to the deserving students subject to the availability of fund :—

- (1) Secretary to the Government of Mizoram of the concerned Department ... Chairman.
- (2) The Director of Department ... Member Secretary.
- (3) Secretary to the Government of Mizoram, Finance Department or his representative ... Member.

Award of stipend 7. The Government of Mizoram may give all or any selected students a monthly stipend as prescribed below from time to time by the Administrator as may be considered necessary.

COURSES	STIPEND PER MONTH
(a) Survey Short Term Course	Rs 150/-
(b) Survey Long Term or Basic Course.	Rs 200/-

Duration of stipend 8. (a) The grant of stipend once made will be tenable for the state at which it is given to the completion of the course subject to good conduct and regularity in attendance.

(b) Stipend may be renewed from year to year.

(c) If a student studying Survey Training Course fails in the examination for the first time in the entire course of study, he may be given another chance by renewing the stipend provided the student is required to attend the class as a regular student and the Administrator is satisfied that the reason for such failure is not due to negligence and carelessness on the part of the student, and that would be treated as a renewal case. For a student studying in Basic Course of Survey the stipend may be renewed upto the extent of only two failures which should not be consecutive during the entire course of study provided he is required to attend the class as a regular student and the Administrator is satisfied that the reasons for the failure is not due to negligence and carelessness on the part of the student.

(d) The selected candidates may be given Travelling Allowances entitled to initial joining the institution and also for return journey on completion of the whole course as well as the Travelling Expenses on Study Tour conducted by the Institutes.

Execution of Bond 9. Student selected for stipend shall execute a Bond in a prescribed form appended hereto as Appendix 'A' on successful completion of the course for which the stipend is

awarded shall serve under the Government of Mizoram for a minimum period of 5 (five) years, if required by the Administrator. In case the student leaves the College/Institute before passing the final course without the permission of the Administrator for any reason whatsoever including illness, discharge or dismissal for misconduct or after having entered in the Government Service if he/she refuses to serve the period specified in the Bond shall be liable to refund all sums paid to him/her by the Administrator while in studies with 5% interest thereon.

- Payment 10. (a) The stipend to the students shall be payable from the month of his/her joining the course of study to the month in which the final examination is completed.
- (b) The stipend shall be payable to students studying courses including summer/winter vacations failing in their course of Study.
- (c) The amount of stipend due in respect of the student shall be paid through the Head of the Institution.
- (d) In addition to the stipend the students shall be paid the expenditure for study tours organised by Institutions at the rate of actual fare for road and rail journeys, provided the expenditure is certified by respective Institution authorities.
- (e) In the case of the death of a student, the amount of stipend due to him/her upto the end of the month the student has attended the institution shall be paid to the parents/Guardians/Legal heir of the student through the Head of Institution.
- (f) The statutory fees and Tuition Fee for each course as prescribed by the Institute for each Trainee will be borne by the Department.

#### AGREEMENT BOND

And whereas the caudidated has, in cosideration of his nomination agreed to complete this training for the said course subject to the conditions hereinafter appearing :

Now, therefore, this agreement witness and it is hereby agreed as follows :--

1. The candidate shall deligently complete his/her training for the said course at the said Institution shall abide by the rules of the said institution for the being in time in force regulating the conduct of students at the Institution and shall pass all the examinations prescribed for the said course, by the Institution concerned.

2. In a student fails in an examination of the course, the monthly stipend may be continued to be paid for repeating the same provided such exemption will be valid for two failures only which should not be consecutive during the currency of the basic course and one failure in Short Term Course. If a student has more failures he/she will have to repeat the Course at his/her own expenses and the stipend will be resumed thereafter.

3. On demand made by the Government of Mizoram within six months of the successful completion of the course, the candidate shall serve for not less than five years under the Government of Mizoram.

4. If the candidate leaves the said Institution before passing the final examination without the previous permission of the Government in writing for any reason whatever including illness or if he is discharged or dismissed for misconduct or if he/she otherwise fails to complete the course or refuses to serve the Government or resigns or is dismissed for misconduct from such service, before the completion of five years of services, then in any such event, he/she shall pay to the President/Administration and without a demur the award of stipend or such proportion as mentioned under Rule 8 of the Rules for ward of the stipend. The decision of the Mizoram Government under this clause as to the commission of a breach, as also to the amount of compensation, payable in respect thereof, shall be final and binding on the candidate.

5. Any sum failling due from the candidate under this agreement may be recovered from him as an arrear of land revenue.

6. If any dispute shall arise between the parties hereto in respect of this agreement, or any of the provision herein contained of anything arising hereout

except in respect of matters on which the decision of the Government of Mizoram under clause 9 is declared to be final.

7. The student granted stipend under clause 8 of the Rules shall not enjoy any other stipend or Scholarship without specific sanction of the Government.

8. The Government shall bear the stamp duty payable in respect of this agreement.
