**ANNEXURE TO GOVT. OF MIZORAM'S NOTIFICATION
NO. MHE. 130/79/102 DT. 26TH MARCH, 1982.**

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF DEPUTATION

1. PERIOD OF DEPUTATION:

The period of deputation will be for 3 (three) years initially. For this the period will start from the date she is relieved to join Service in Nagaland upto the day she resumes duty in Mizoram after her services has been replaced at the disposal of her parent Government.

2. **PAY** : She may either opt for her grade pay in the parent Govt. or the pay of the post in Nagaland i.e. Rs. 650-35-745-EB-35-1025-EB-40-1225/-p.m.
3. **DEPUTATION ALLOWANCE** : She will be entitled to deputation allowance at the rate of 20% of her grade pay in the parent Department if she opts for the grade pay in her parent Govt., subject to the conditions that the deputation allowance should not exceed Rs. 250/-p.m. and also subject to the condition that her grade pay plus deputation allowance should not exceed the maximum of the pay of the post in Nagaland i.e. Rs. 1225/-p.m.
4. **DEARNESS ALLOWANCE**: If she opts for her grade pay in the parent Government DA will be admissible as per rates in the parent Government or if she opts for the pay of the post in Nagaland DA will be admissible as per Nagaland Government rates.
5. **NON-PRACTISING ALLOWANCE** : NPA will be admissible at Nagaland Government rates.
6. **HOUSE RENT ALLOWANCE** : Simple accomodation, subject to availability on payment of maintainance charges or house rent allowance as admissible to Government servants in Nagaland.
7. **JOINING TIME PAY AND TRANSFER T.A.** : She will be entitled to TA and joining time, both on joining the post on deputation and on reversion there from to the parent Government under the rules and states of Nagaland Government. The expenditure on this will be borne by the Government of Nagaland.
8. **TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE**:
For journey on duty during the period of deputation, she will be entitled to get TA at the rates in force in Nagaland.
9. **LEAVE & PENSION** :
During the period of deputation she will continue to be governed by the leave and pension rules of her parent Government applicable to her. The allocation of leave salary and pensionary charges will be regulated under the rules of allocation contained in Appendix-3 to Account Code, Vol-1.
10. **PROVIDENT FUND ACCOUNTS** :
During the period of deputation she will continue to subscribe to the provident fund of her parent Government to which she may be subscribing when she is placed on deputation in accordance with rules of such fund. If she is governed by contributory provident fund Rules, Government contribution will be paid by the Nagaland Government for the period of deputation.
11. **MEDICAL CONCESSION** :
As admissible under Nagaland Government rules.
