Subject :- Nomination of no more than three persons as members to the Selection Committee.

No.A. 32012/1/81-APT (B), the 23rd June, 1987. In pursuance of the Government Notification No.A. 32012/1/81-APT (B) dt. 23.6.1987 Government is to nominate not more than three persons as members to the Selection Committee from time to time. For this purpose, nomination of such members shall be made by the Chief Minister, the nomination will be obtained by the General Service Wing of Department of Personal & Administrative Reforms in their files from time to time.

No. A. 32012/1/81-APT(B), the 23rd June, 1987. Government of Mizoram have constituted a State Selection Committee which will function as DPC as per procedure laid down in Appendix-29 to Civil Service Regulations. The Selection Committee is constituted for making recommendations in matters of appointments/promotions etc. to Group A & B categories of posts. Appointments/promotions made on the recommendations of the Selection Committee in accordance with the approved Recruitment Rule will be regular appointments. There are, however, several cases of adhoc appointments/promotions made to various Group A & B posts in the past. Such adhoc appointments/promotions were made earlier due to exigencies of service and in the public interest. For some of the posts, there are approved Recruitment Rules and some other appointments were made on the recommendation of adhoc DPC on the basis of draft Recruitment Rules. They are yet to be regularised.

The question and the manner regarding regularisation with of such adhoc appointments were examined in consultation with the Law & Judicial Department. It has now been decided that those cases will now be taken up for regularisation by the DPC/Government in accordance with the approved Recruitment Rules. In other cases where, there is no approved Recruitment Rule for such posts, Department concerned should take immediately steps to finalise Recruitment Rule and take further action.

All Departments are therefore requested to submit complete proposals for examination of such adhoc appointments/promotions for regularisation. The pro-

 proposals should be compiled in a proper statement for which a proforma is enclosed herewith. The proposals should be compiled in Chronological Orders. The statement should be compiled in such manner that each group in that categories form their own group. The merit/seniority list made by the DPC should be retained. The General Service Wing of the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms will examine the cases and obtain approval of the competent authority for regularisation of such adhoc appointments. The proposals should include only cases of adhoc appointments/promotions to Group A & B posts for which there is/ are approved and notified Recruitment Rules.
