Consequent upon the enquiry against the activities of Darlawn Village Council, it is found that the Village Council of Darlawn acted in a manner prejudicial to the interest of the states and also against public interest. The Governor of Mizoram is opinion that the Village Council of Darlawn is too inefficient to carry on the Village Administration.
