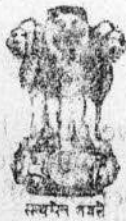

ix) The Association shall not maintain any political fund or lend itself to the propagation of the views of any political party or politician.

x) All representations by the Association shall be submitted through proper channel, and shall, as a normal practice, be addressed to the Secretary or the Head of Department or office.

xi) A list of members and office bearers, and up-to-date copy of the rules and an audited statement of accounts of the Association shall be furnished to the Govt. annually through proper channel after the general annual meeting so as to reach the Govt. before the 1st day of July each year.

xii) Any amendment of a substantial character in the rules of the Association shall be made only with the previous approval of Govt., and any other amendment of minor importance shall be communicated through proper channel for transmission to the Govt. for information.

xiii) The previous permission of the Govt. shall be taken before the Association seeks affiliation with any other Service Association or Federation.

xiv) The Association shall cease to be affiliated to a federation or Confederation of Service Associations whose recognition is withdrawn by the Government.

xv) The Associations shall not start or published any periodical magazine or bulletin without the previous approval of the Govt.

## BENEFITS

1. Continuous power of 3.5 MW will be available for the whole year and full capacity will be available for 6 (six) months. This will solve the present power crisis in the state.
2. The project will provide benefits on navigation, fish culture and water shed management. The navigation will facilitate development of the villages upto Kawnpui.
3. The availability of water will help in supply water to all villages at the up stream upto Kawnpui for domestic use.
4. The Lake will promote the tourism and the same can be made an attractive Tourist Centre.

## REHABILITATION PLAN FOR SERLUI-'B' PROJECT

Serlui 'B' Medium Hydel Project with an installed capacity of 10.5 MW is located in the Northern part of Mizoram East of the Aizawl-Silchar National

Highway and on the river Serlui 'B'. It envisages construction of 51.3 m high earthfill dam, with a catchment area of 397 Sqkm and submergence at minimum reservoir of an area of 2554 Ha.

On the Commissioning of this Project, the reservoir will submerge one village fully. This village, Builum, with a population of 60 families, will have to be relocated in nearby areas. An area has been selected by Power & Electricity Department in consultation with department of Agriculture, Revenue, Forest and Rehabilitation. The area identified is located between forest revenue reserves of Serlui 'B' river and Chemlui river on Kolasib-Builum P.W.D. road. According to soil survey conducted by Agriculture Department for catchment of adjoining basin (refer map enclosed) the land is hilly with slopes varying from 5% to 25% and Land capacity classification of IIIe and IVe. According to Agriculture Department, the lands are very fit for terrace cultivation of paddy, sugarcane etc. and horticultural crops like bananas, oranges and various other fruits etc. According to the norms of the Government of Mizoram for Jhum Control Programme, land of 2Ha. area is given to each family of a village to change over from Jhum Cultivation to a more permanent cultivation like terrace farming and horticulture. But for the rehabilitation of the village of Builum, it is proposed to allot to each family, an area of 4Ha. each of non-forest land so that they may restle comfortable in their new location. The areas proposed for rehabilitation are Revenue Department land and will be available free of cost.

The detailed schemes of the financial implications as included in the Project Estimate, is as shown in the annexure enclosed.
