### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF BILKHAWTHLIR TOWN AREA

#### STARTING POINT :

The first Boundary Pillar was fixed at the coordinate of 92deg-42'-26" longitude, 24deg-18'-56" Latitude in the western edge of the road leading to Aizawl, the place is locally known as quarry peng.

#### SOUTH :

From B.P.No.1 the boundary line follows Hmar luang lui, Boundary Pillar No 2 was fixed at the co-ordinate of 92deg-42'-00" longitude, 24deg-19'-15" latitude.

#### WEST :

From B.P.No.1 the boundary line follows small stream, directed Lalringa's farm kawn, (Saddle) and follows small stream. The stream meets Chhimluangte river. The boundary line follows Chhimluang lui upto khankawn, the boundary line runs along small stream upto the tri-junction of Daplei lui and small stream. The tri-junction was treated as Pillar No. 3 and the co-ordinate is 92deg-42'-52" longitude and 24deg-21'-14" latitude.

#### NORTH :

From B.P.NO.3 the boundary line runs along Daplei lui upto KM Stone No.4 which was in the eastern edge of NH-54. From KM Stone No.4 boundary line follows Thingdelh lui up to the co-ordinate of 92deg-44'-25" latitude at this point B.P. No.4 was fixed.

#### EAST :

From B.P.No.4 the boundary line runs to the following points, Lalzuii huan mawnger kawn, Thankhuma chul kawn, Pu Khianga kuhva huan bul kawn (this point is just near to footpath leading to Chemphai) then follows small stream upto the tri-junction of Lungzawn lui. From this point the boundary line runs along Lungzawn lui upto Thlanvawng kawn, from this point, the boundary line pass through the following points, Camp mual mawngkawn, Lalbeiseia huan kawn and tri-junction of stream, on this point B.P.No.5 was fixed at the co-ordinate of 92deg-43'-11" longitude, 24deg -18'-43" latitude.

SOUTH :

From B.P.No.5 the boundary line directed to B.P.No.1 which was fixed are quarry peng.

#### CLASSIFICATION OF LAND WITHIN THE SPECIFIED TOWN AREA OF BILKHAWTHLIR

- I—GRADE :** Both sides of the main road/street within the perimeter of 30.48 metres/100 feet horizontally from the edge of the road/street to those sites having frontage/return-frontage to the side of the road/street only, which are :—
1. From pillar No. 1 coinciding with eucalyptus tree at quarry peng to pillar No. 2 fixed in front of -- Lalthlamuana J.E. (PWD) house site at Changel Kawn.
  2. From pillar No. 2 at Changel kawn to Pillar No. 3 which was fixed in front of Pu Lalzuala's building at Kualmawi veng.
  3. From pillar No. 2 as mentioned in Sl. No. 1 road leading to P.W.D. inspection Bungalow to Pillar No. 3 at Kualmawi veng.
  4. From Pillar No. 3 at Kualmawi veng to Pillar No. 4, which was fixed in front of Pi Saikungi's shop at — Vengchep.
  5. From Pillar No. 3 as mentioned in Sl. No. 4, road leading to Agriculture inspection Bungalow, to Pillar No. 4 as mentioned in Sl. No. 4.
  6. From Pillar No. 4 as mentioned in Sl. No. 4 to Pillar No. 5 which was fixed just near to Km Stone No. 4.

**II—GRADE :** Both sides of Motorable/Jeepable road/street within the perimeter of 30.48 M./100 feet horizontally from the edge of the road/street to those site having frontage/return-frontage to the side of the road/street which are :—

1. All road along the Motorable/Jeepable roads which are not included in the 1st Grade within the specified town area of Bilkhawthlir.

III—GRADE : All lands which are not included in the I&II Grades within the specified town area of Bilkhawthlir are classed under this Grade.

N O T E

- 1) All Government Residential area for V.I.P.'s under the Government of Mizoram/Central are classed under the 1st Grade.
- 2) If any two or more Grades are overlapped/met at any particular place, the highest grade shall be used.

Rangers of Mizoram Forest Department.

1. FOR GAME WATCHERS, FOREST GUARDS, FORESTERS AND DEPUTY RANGERS:-
