Under the provision in Section 6 of the North Eastern Areas (Re-organisation) Act, 1971 Mizoram has been formed as a new Union Territory with effect from 21-1-72 comprising Territories which immediately before were comprised in the Mizo District in the State of Assam. Mizoram Government have not made any legislation imposing Sales Tax. No State Sales Tax shall, therefore, be payable in respect of sale of goods to any dealer or consumer in Mizoram until such tax is imposed under due process of law by the Government of Mizoram.

This is in partial modification of the Notification issued under No. FMT. 3/72/7 date 30-5-72.

Memo No. RIP. 1/72, the 25th October, 1972.—Applications are invited from the Citizens of India, for the post of Project Officer, Rural Industries Project, under the Govt. of Mizoram, in the scale of pay of Rs. 750-50-9504EB-50-1200/- p.m. plus all other local allowances i.e. D.A. Rs 100/- p.m., SCA 15% of basic pay subject to a minimum of Rs 100/- p.m. and maximum of Rs 125/- p.m., Hill Allowance Rs 75/- p.m. and Adhoc Allowance @ Rs. 65/- p.m. as admissible under the rules from time to time.

- 2. Application will be received by the undersigned upto 26th. November, 1972.
- 3. The candidate must be a Graduate in Engineering or equivalent degree from a recognised University having at least six years experience. Preference will be given to those possessing higher qualification.
- 4. Age must be within the prescribed age limit i.e. 29 years on 1st. January, 1972, but is relaxable by 5 years for Scheduled Caste and Schedule Tribe candidates and certain

categories of displaced persons. For Government servants upper age limit is further relaxable.

- 5. Application must be accompanied with a Treasury Chalan of Rs. 5/- (Rs. 2.50 for Scheduled Caste Schedule Tribe and Political sufferers and War Service personnel) deposited into the Treasury under the Head of Account "XXI—Misc. Department Examination fee receipt of Government of Mizoram. Fees are not refundable and no postal or money orders or stamps will be accepted in lieu of Treasury receipt. Candidates if called for, must be prepared to appear for a written test or interview at their own expense.
