THE COAL MINES (TAKING OVER OF MANAGEMENT) ORDINANCE, 1973

No. 1 OF 1973

Promulgated by the President in the Twenty-fourth Year of the Republic of India.

An Ordinance to provide for the taking over, in the public interest, of the management of coal mines, pending nationalisation of such mines.

WHEREAS it is expedient in the public interest that the coal mines should be nationalised with a view to ensuring mational and co-ordinated development of coal production and for promoting optimum utilisation of the coal resources consistent with the growing requirement of the economy;

AND WHEREAS is it expendient, in the public interest, to take over the management of coal mines pending nationalisation thereof;

AND WHEREAS Parliament is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action ;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 123 of the Constitution, the President is pleased promulgate the following Ordinance :--

CHAPTER I

PRELIMINARY

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Coal Mines) Taking Over of- Short title and Management: Ordinance, 1973.

commencement,

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires -(a) "appointed day" means the 31st day of January, 1973;

Definitions.

(b) "coal mine" means a mine in which there exists one or more seams of coal;

(c) "company" means a company as defined in section 5 of the Companies Act, 1956, and includes a foreign company within the meaning of section 591 of that Act.

 (d_i) 'Custodian," in relation to a coal mine, means the person appointed under section 5 to take over the management of the coal mine;

(e) "Government company" has the meaning assigned to it by section 617 of the Companies Act 1956;

(f) "managing contractor" means the person or body of persons, who, with the previous consent in writing of the State Government has entered into an arrangement, contract or understanding, with the owner of the mine, under which the operations of the mine are substantially controlled by such person or body of persons;

(g) "mine" means any excavation where any operation for the purpose of searching for or obtaining minerals has been or being carried on and includes—

(i) all borings and bore holes;

(ii) all shafts adjacent to, belonging to, or in, a mine whether in the course of being sunk or not;

(iii) all levels and inclined planes in the course of being driven;

(iv) all open cast working;

(v) all conveyors or aerial ropeways provided for the bringing into or removal from a mine of minerals or other articles of for the removal of refuse therefrom;

(vi) all lands, buildings, works, adits, levels, planes, machinery and equipment, vehicles, railways, tramways and sidings adjacent to, belonging to, or in, a mine:

(vii) all workshops belonging to or in, a mine including buildings, machinery, instruments, stores, epuipment of such workshops and the lands on which such workshops stand;

(viii) all coal in stock or in transit or under production and other stores, stocks and instruments belonging to, or ina mine;

(ix) all power stations belonging to, or in, a mine, or operated for supplying electricity for the purpose of working the mine or a number of mines under the same management f of 1965,

(x) all lands, buildings and equipment adjacent to, belonging to, or in, or stituated on the surface of, a mine where the washing of coal or manufacture of coke is carried on, whether or not such lands, buildings and equipment belong to the owner of the coal mine;

(xi) all other assets, movable or immovable, belonging to a mine whether within the premises or outside, including cash balances, reserve funds and investments in so far as they relate to the coal mine and also any money lawlully due to the coal mine in relation to any period prior to the appointed day;

(h) "mining mompany" means a company owning a coal mine, and in relation to a foreign company within the meaning of section 591 of the Companies Act, 1956, the undertaking of that company in India;

(i) "notified order" means an order notified in the Official Gazette ;

(j) words and expressions used herein and not defined but defined in the Coul Mines (Conservation, Safety and Development) Act, 1952, have the meanings respectively assigned to them in that Act;

(k) words and expressions used herein and not defined in this Ordinance or in the Coal mines (Conservation, Safety and Development) Act 1952, have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the Mines Act, 1952

CHAPTER II

MANAGEMENT OF COAL MINES

3. (1) On and from the appointed day, the management of all coal mines shall vest in the Central Government.

(2) The coal mines specified in the Schedule shall be deemed, for the purposes of this Ordinauce, to be the coal mines the manegement of which shall vest, under sub section (I), in the Central Government:

Provided that if, after the appointed day, any other mine is found after an investigation, to contain coal, the Central Government shall make declaration to that effect and on and from the date of such declaration—

(i) the management of such mine shall be deemed, for the purposes of this Ordinance, to vest in the Central Government; and

(ii) such coal mine shall be deemed to be included in the Schedule, and thereupon the provisions of this Ordinance shall become applicable thereto subject to the modification that for the words "appointed day" wherever they occur, the words, brackets and figures "the date of tha declaration made by the Central Government under subsection (2) of section \mathfrak{P} " shall be substituted.

(3) For the removal of doubts it is hereby declared whit the Schedule includes those coal mines in relation to which the declaration made by the Coal Board to the effect that they contain coking could is in dispute.

4. (1) Pending the appointment of a Custodian under section 5 for any coal mine, the person in charge of the management of such mine immediately before the appointed day shall on and from the appointed day, be in charge of the management of such mine for and on behalf of the Central Government; and the management of such mine shall be carried on by such person subject to the provisions contained in sub-sections (3) and (5) and such directions, if any, as the Central Government may give to him and no other person, including the owner, shall so long as such management continues, exercise any powers of management.

(2) Any contract, whether express or implied, gradiding for the management of any coal mine, made before the appointed day between the owner of such mine and any person in charge of the appagement of such mine immediately before the appointed day, shall be dramed to have terminated on the appointed day.

(3) No person in charge of the management of a cost mine shall, without the previous approval of the person specified by the Clentral Government in this behalf in respect of that mine (hereinable, referred to as the "authorised person"),—

(a) incur any expenditure from the assets appertaining to the coal mine otherwise than for the purpose of making routine pays onts of salaries or commissions to employees, agents or for the purpuse of meeting the routine day to day expenditure;

(b) transfer or otherwise dispose of any such assure or create any charge, hypothecation, lien or other incumbrance therein;

(c) invest in any manner any monies forming part of such assets ;

(d) acquire any immovable property out of the montes forming part of such assets;

(e) enter into any contract of service or agency, whether expressly or by implication, for purposes connected wholly or partly with the coal mine or vary the terms and conditions of any such contract subjisting on the appointed day;

(f) enter into any other transaction relating to the business of the coal mine or vary the terms of any agreement relating to such business subsisting at the commencement of this Ordinance.

(4) The approval of the authorised person may be given either generally in relation to centain classes of transactions relating to the coal mine or specially in relation to any of its transactions.

Mapagement of goal mines pending the appointment of Custodian

,

(5) Every person in charge of the management of a coal mine shall deposit all securities and documents of title to any assets appertaining to such mine in any Scheduled Bank or Nationalised Bank in which the owner or, agent had an acc unt immediately before the appointed day or in any branch of the State Bank in the place where the head office or the principal office of the coal mine is situated or where there is no branch of the Stated Bank in such place the nearest branch of the State Bank; and no such security or document shall be withdrawn from the Scheduled Bank, the Nationalised Bank or the State Bank, as the case may be, except with the permission of the authorised person;

Provided that nothing contained in this sub section shall apply to any security or document of title kept in trust with an Official Trustee in pursuance of the articles of association of any mining company unless the Central Government, by notified order, otherwise directs.

Explanation .- In this sub-section, -

(a) "Scheduled Bank" means a bank included for the time being in the Second Schedule to the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934;

(b) "State Bank" means the State Bank of India consitituted under the State Bank of India Act, 1955;

(c) "Natoinclised Bank" means a corresponding new Bank as defined in the Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertakings) Act, 1970.

(6) Every person in charge of the management of a coal mine shall deliver forthwith to the person specified in this behalf by the Central Government in respect of that coal mine the following documents, namely :—

(a) the minutes book or any other book in India containing all resolutions, up to the appointed day of the persons in charge of the management of the coal mine before the appointed day;

(b) the current checue books relating to the coal mine which are at the head office or the principal office of the coal mine;

(e) all registers or other books containing particulars relating to the investment of any monies appertaining to the coal mine including investments on mortgaged properties and all loans granted or advances made.

(7) Without prejudice to the generality of the powers conferred by subsection (1) and the provisions contained in sub-sections (3), (5) and (6), any directions issued under sub-section (1) may require the persons in charge of the management of a coal mine under this Ordinance to furnish to the Central Government or to the authorised person such returns, statements and other information relating to the coal mine as may be mentioned in the direction.

(8) The persons in charge of the management of the coal mine under this Ordinance shall be entitled to such remunneration. Whether by way of allwance or salary or perquisites as the Central Gavernment may fix; and any such person may by giving one month's notice in writing to the Central Government of his intention so to do, relinquish charge of the management of the coal mine.

(1) The Central Government may, as soon as it is convenient administratively so, to do, appoint any person as Custodian for the purpose of C taking over the management of one or more coal mines and the person so, v appointed shall carry on the management of such mines for and on behalf ap of the Central Government.

(2) (a) The Central Government may also appoint a person (including a Government company, whether in existence at the commencement of this Ordinance or incorporated thereafter), as the Custodian-General for exercising supervision and control over all the coal mines the management of which is taken over under this Ordinance and on such appointment, every Custodian, appointed under sub section (1), shall act under the guidance, control and supervision of the Custodian-General.

(b) The Central Government may also appoint one or more persons as Additional Custodian-General or Deputy Custodian-General for assisting the Custodian-General in the exercise of his powers and duties under this Ordinance and the Custodion-General may delegate all or such of his powers as he may think fit to the Additional or Deputy Custodion General.

(e) Every Additional or Deputy Custodion-General shall exercise the powers delegated to him under the control and supervision of the Custodian-General.

(3) Un the appointment of a Custodian under subsection (i), the charge of management of the coal mine shall vest in him and all persons in charge of the management of such mine immediately before such appointment shall cease to be in charge of such management and shall be bound to deliver to the Custodian all assets, books of account, registers or other documents in their custody relating to the coal mine, and any contract, whether express or implied, providing for the management of such coal mine, made before the appointed day between the owner of such mine and every such person, shall be deemed to have terminated on the date on which the Custodian is appointed.

(4) Notwithstanding any judgment, decree or order of any Court or any thing contained in any other law for the time being in force, the Official Liquidator or any Receiver appointed by any Court or any other person, in whose possession, custody or control any mine specified in the Schedule or any part thereof may be, shall forthwith deliver possession of the mine or such part thereof, as the case may be to the Custodian.

(5) The Official Liquidator, Receiver or any other person who has, on the appointed day, in his possession, custody or control any books, documents or other papers relating to any mine specified in the Schedule, shall be liable to occount for the said books, documents or other papers to the Central Government and shall deliver them up to the Custodian or to such person as the Custodian may specify in this behalf.

(6) The Central Government may authorise the Custodian to exercise such of the powers of the owner including powers to borrow, as may be necessary for the proper management of the coal mine and the Central Government may also issue such directions to the Custodion as to his powers and duties as it may deem desirable in the circumstances of the case; and no other person, including the owner, shall, so long as such management continues, exercise any powers of management in relation to the coal mine or give any direction with regard to such management.

(7) The Custodian may also apply to the Central Government at any time for instructions as to the manner in which he shall conduct the management of the coal mine or in relation to any matter arising in the course of such management. (8) The Custodian shall receive from the funds of the coal mine for the charge of management of which he is appointed under sub-section (1), such remuneration as the Central Government may fix;

Provided that where a Government company has been appointed as the Custodian of more than one coal mine, the remuneration of the Custodian shall be received from the funds of each such coal mine in such proportion as may be determined by the Central Government.

(9) The Custodian-General and every -

(i) Additional Custodian-General,

(ii) Deputy Custodian-General,

(iii) Custodian,

shall hold office during the pleasure of the Central Government.

(10) The Central Government shall receive, to the exclusion of all other persons, any monics due to the coal mine realised after the appointed day notwithstanding that such receipt pertains to a transaction made at any time before the appointed day.

6. (1) Every owner of a coal mines shall be given by the Central Go- Payment of vernment an amount in cash, for the vesting in it, under section 3, of the amount, management of such mine.

(2) For every month during which the management of a coal mine remains vested in the Central Government, the amount referred to in sub-section (1) shall be computed at the rate of twenty paise per tonne of coal an the highest monthly production of coal from such mine during any month in the years 1969,1970, 1971 and 1972;

Provided that if in relation to any such coal mine, there was no production of coal during the said years the amount referred to in sub section (1) shall be computed at the rate of twenty paise per tonne of such highest monthly coal producing capacity of the coal mine before the appointed day, as may be assessed and declared by the Coal Board:

Provided further that in relation to a coal mine, the operations of which were immediately before the appeinted day under the control of a managing contractor, the amount as computed under this sub-section, shall be apportioned between the owner of the coal mine and such managing contractor in such proportions as may be agreed upon by or between the owner and such contractor, and in the event of there being no such agreement, in such proportions as may be determined by the principal civil court of original within the local limits of whose jurisdiction the head office of the coal mine is stiluated.

(3) For every month during which the management of a coke oven plant, which fulls within the definition of coal mine, remains vested in the Central Government under this Ordinance, there shall be given by the Central Government, in cash, in addition to the amount specified in sub section (1), to the owner of such coke oven plant, an amount computed at the rate of fifty paise per towne of coke on the highest monthly production of coke from such coke oven plant during any month in the years 1969, 1970, 1971 and 1972.

CHAPTER III

MISCELLANEOUS

Penalties

7. If any person-

(a) fails to deliver to the Custodian any assets, book of account, registers or any other document in his custody relating to the coal mine in respect of the management of which the Custodian has been appointed, or

(b) retains any property of such coal mine or removes or destroys it, or

(c) fails to comply with the provisions contained in sub-section (2) or sub-section (5) or sub-section (6) of 4, or

d) fails to comply with any directions issued under sub-section (1), read with sub section (7), of section 4,

he shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years, or with the which may extend to ten thousand voluces, or with both.

8. (1) Where an offence under this Ordinance has been committed by a company, every person who at the time the offence was committed was in charge of, and was responsible to, the company for the conduct of the business of the company, as well as the company, shall be depend to be guilty of the offence and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly :

Provided that nothing contained in this sub-section shall reader any such person liable to any punishment, if he proves that the offense was committed without his knowledge or that he had exercised all due d ligence to prevent the commission of such offence.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1), where any offence under this Ordinance has been committed by a containing and it is proved that the offence has been committed with the consolit or connivance of, or is attributable to, any neglect on the part of, any director, manager, secretary or other officer of the company, such director, manager, secretary or other officer shall be deemed to be guilty of that officies and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly.

Explanation—For the purposes of this section—

(a) "company" means any body corporate and identities a firm or other association of individuals; and

(b) 'director", in relation to a firm, means a partner in the firm.

9. No proceeding for the winding up of a mining complay, the management of whose coal mines has vested in the Central Covernment under this Ordinance, or for appointment of a Receiver or for any other order in respect of the business of such company, shall lie in any Court except with the consent of the Central Government.

10. In computing the period of limitation prescribed by any law for the time being in force for any suit or application against any person by a mining company in respect of any matter arising out of any (ransaction in relation to any coal mine owned by such company, the time during which this Ordinance is in force shall be excluded.

Offences by companies.

13. The provisions of this Ordinance shall have effect notwithstanding anything inconsistent therewith contained in any other law for the time being in force or in any instrument having effect by virtue of any law other than whis Ordinance or in any decree or order of any Court.

12. (1) The Central Government may, by notified order, direct that all or E any of the powers exercisable by it under this Ordinance may also be exercised by any person or persons as may be specified in the order.

(2) Whenever any delegation of power is made under sub-section (1), the person to whom such power has been delegated shall act under the direction, control and supervision of the Central Government.

18. (1) No suit prosecution or other legal proceeding shall lie against the Custodian-General, Additional Custodian General, Deputy Custodion-General, any Custodian or authorised person in respect of anything which is in good faith done or intended to be done under this Ordinance.

(2) No suit or other legal proceeding shall lie against the Central Government or the Custodian General. Additional Custodian-General. Deputy Custodian-General, any Custodian or authorised person for any damage caused or likely to be caused by anything which is in good faith done or intended to be done under this Ordinance.

44. (1) If the Central Government is satisfied; after such inquiry as it may think fit that any contract or agreement entered into at any time within twelve months immediately preceding the appointed day, between the owner, agent or manager of a coal mine and any other person has been entered into in bad faith or is detrimental to the interests of the coal mine, it may make an order cancelling or varying either unconditionally or subject to such conditions as it may think fit to impose the contract or agreement and theresfter the contract or agreement shall have effect accordingly.

Provided that no contract or agreement shall be cancelled or varied except after giving to the parties to the contract or agreement a reasonable opportunity of being heard.

(2) Any person aggrieved by an order made under sub-section (1) may make an application to the principal court of civil jurisdiction within the local limits of whose jurisdiction the head office of the coal mine is situated for the variation or reversal of such order and thereupon such court may confirm, modify or reverse such order.

15. If the Custodian is of opinion that any contract of employment enterred into by any owner or agent of a coal mine at any time before the appointed day is unduly onerous, he may by giving to the employee one month's notice in writing or the salary or wages for one month in lieu thereof, terminate such contract of empoyment.

16. (1) The Centaal Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, make rules to carry out the provisiona of this Ordinance.

(2) In particular, and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing power, such rules may provide for all or any of the following matters, namely :--

(a) the manner in which the coal mines shall be managed by the Custodian under the control and supervision of the Custodian-General;

THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT BANK OF INDIA (AMENDMENT) ACT. 1972

AN ACT

to amend the Industrial Development Bank of India Act. 1964.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Twenty third Year of the Republic of India as follows :---

1. This Act may be called the Industrial Development Bank of Short title India (Amendment) Act, 1972.

2. In section 2 of the Industrial Development Bank of India Act, Amendment of 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act),section 2.

(a) in clause (c), the words "or in the maintenance, repair, testing or servicing of machinery of any description or vehicles or vessels or motorboats or trailers or tractors, or in fishing, or in providing shore facilities for fishing or maintenance thereof" shall be added at the end;

(b) in clause (i), for the word "Madras", the words "Tamil" Nadu" shall be substituted.

3. In section 9 of the principal Act, in sub-section (1),-

(c) in clause (c) for the words "any other financial institution," the words "any other financial institution, whether within or outside India," shall be substituted;

(d) in clause (d),—

(i) in the proviso, for the words "which may at the op ion of the Development Bank be convertible," the words "the amounts outstanding thereon may be convertible at the option of the Development Bank" shall be substituted; (ii) after the proviso, the following Explanation shall be inserted, namely:---

"Explanation.—In this clause, the expression "the amounts cutstanding thereon" used in relation to any loan or advance, shall mean the principal, interest and other charges payable on such loan or advance as at the time when the amounts are sought to be converted into stocks or shares.";

(e) after clause (d) and the Explanation thereto, the following shauses shall be inserted namely :—

"(da) granting loans and advances —

(i) to any person exporting products of industrial concerns; or

(ii) to any person outside India, in connection with the export of capital goods from India; or

(iii) for the execution of turn-key projects outside India by any industrial concern or by any person in India;

(db) transferring for consideration any instrument relating to loans and advances granted by it to industrial concerns;";

(f) after clause (k), the following clause shall be inserted namely:

"(ka) acting as agent of —

(i) the Central Government or of the Reserve Bank, or i

(ii) such other Government or person as the Central Government, on the recommendation of the Reserve Bank, may authorise;".

4. After section 9 of the principal Act, the following section shall insertion of new section 9 A.

'9A. (I) The Development Bank shall not enter into any kind of business with any industrial concern, of which any of the directors Iof the Development Bank is a proprietor, partner, director, manager, agent, employee or guarantor or in which one or more directors of the Development Bank together hold substantial interest :

Provided that this subsection shall not apply to any industrial concern if any director of the Development Bank -

(i) is nominated as a director of the Board of such concern by Government, or a Government company as defined in section 617 of the Companies Act, 1956 or by a Corporation established by any other law; or

(ii) is elected on the Board of such concern by virtue of shares he'd in the concern by Government, or a Government company as defined in section 617 of the Companies Act, 1956, or by a Corporation established by any other law,
