DECLARATION

No. LRR. 38/73/24, the 17th. October, 1973. Whereas it appears to the Government of Mizoram that land is required to be taken by Govt. at the expense of the Headquarters 81 Border Security Force for a public purpose viz for construction of Headquarters 81 Border Security Force near Sairang Town in the Aizawl District of Mizoram, it is hereby declared that for the above purpose,

land measuring more or less 9 Bighas of standard measuremet bounded on the :—

- East by Sairang—Changsil Motor Road.
 West by Chengkawilui Stream.
 South by A stream which runs between Pu Hrangchhunga and Pu H.K. Bawichhuaka's land.
 North by Along Chengkawilui Stream, is required within the a for-
 said area near Sairang. This declaration is made under
 the provisions of Section 6 of Act 1 of 1894 to all whom
 it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the Office of the Collector, Aizawl.

Nothing in this declaration will be considered to apply to land which is resumable for the said purpose under the terms of the lease and whic the Government elect to resume instead of Acquiring under the Act.
