The functions of the District Development Boards will be as follows:—

- (i) To prepare District Annual & Five Year Plans in relation to the needs of the district.
- (ii) To review the progress of various developmental schemes implemented by different departments within the District from time to time on the basis of quarterly progress reports submitted by the local heads of development departments and submit consolidated quarterly reports of the district.
- (iii) To advise on integrated implementation of plans and efficient utilisation of funds alloted and to suggest priorities for expenditure within the sum alloted by the Government, in particular, to recommend measures for effective and speedy fulfilment of schemes of economic and social developments and more especially of Community Development Blocks, Agricultural production programmes, Social services and small Industries.
- (iv) To promote public participation and cooperation in development programmes, and expand local community efforts both in urban and rural areas.
- (v) To help allocation of, and proparation of schemes for utilisation of grants made available for various developmental works under plan and non-plan and centrally sponsored programmes.

The Board should meet as frequently as possible, but at least/once a quarter to discuss various development matters for implementing plan and non-plan schemes, to watch the progress and to remove any deficiencies noticed during a particular period.

Proceeding of the meetings of the Boards should be forwarded to the Proceeding and Development Departments for information. The Planning and Development Departments will, whenever necessary, send relevant extracts to other departments concerned for necessary action.
