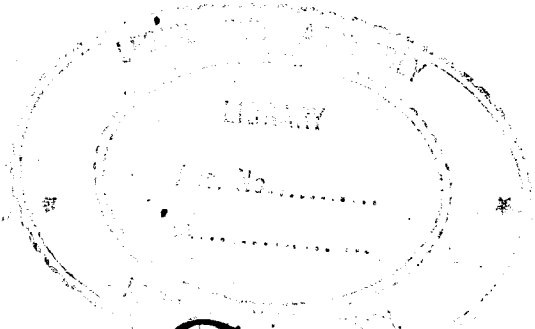

- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
